32nd NATIONAL DISABILITY PREVENTION AND REHABILITATION (NDPR) WEEK

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Division/City Superintendents  
Heads, Public and Private Special Schools

1. The 32<sup>nd</sup> National Disability Prevention and Rehabilitation (NDPR) Week with the theme "*Sa Istrukturang Accessible, Lahat ay Able*" will be observed on July 17-23, 2010.
2. The celebration aims to:
  - a. stimulate public awareness on disability issues and concerns that will strengthen the involvement of government and non-government organizations including self-help organizations of persons with disabilities, the academe, professional groups and societies, local government units, business sector, the media and other entities of the society;
  - b. serve as the vehicle of information for programs implemented by government and non-government organizations that adhere to the promotion of the inherent rights of persons with disabilities;
  - c. encourage Filipino citizens to take active responsibility in the upliftment of the economic and social conditions of the persons with disabilities in the society, thereby encouraging them to take pro-active roles in nation-building;
  - d. generate full media support on the celebration and other disability-related issues and concerns that affect persons with disabilities; and
  - e. develop and strengthen cooperation and partnership between and among the various sectors of the society for better understanding of disability issues and concerns.
3. The Department of Education (DepEd), a member agency of the governing board and the National Council on Disability Affairs (NCDA) shall take part in the implementation of the following suggested activities lined up for the celebration:
  - a. Thanksgiving Mass and Wreath Laying Ceremony at the Mabini Shrine;
  - b. Formal Opening Ceremony;
  - c. Family Fun Day of Persons with Disabilities;
  - d. *Paligsahan ng May "K" sa Kasaysayan at Kultura ng mga Pilipino*;
  - e. Livelihood Exhibits of Products Made by PWDs;
  - f. Poster Making Contest;
  - g. Jobs Fair;




- h. Wellness and Lifestyle Seminar;
- i. Regional Orientation on Accessibility Law and Universal Design Concept;
- j. Community Medical Mission;
- k. Sports Activities;
- l. Information Dissemination/Advocacy;
- m. Commemoration of Mabini's Birthday, July 23; and
- n. Newborn Screening.

4. The aforementioned activities can be conducted at the regional level through the initiative of the Regional Special Education Council (RSEC). Other Government Organizations (GOs), Non-Government Organizations (NGOs) and civic organizations could be tapped for assistance. All Special Education (SPED) centers, public and private schools with SPED programs are encouraged to undertake activities relevant to the theme of the celebration.

5. Furthermore, activities to be undertaken should not disrupt classes as stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005, *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*.

6. A brief consolidated narrative and pictorial report on the celebration shall be submitted to Ms. Mirla R. Olores, Chief, Special Education Division, Bureau of Elementary Education, DepEd Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City. Enclosed is the Agency Feedback Report Form to be used in reporting the activities undertaken/conducted during the week.
