CONSOLIDATION OF PLANS TO MITIGATE EFFECTS OF EL NIÑO/LA NIÑA PHENOMENON IN THE SCHOOL LEVEL INCLUDING THE INTEGRATION OF CLIMATE CHANGE-DISASTER RISK REDUCTION/MANAGEMENT AND ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION TO ELEMENTARY AND HIGH SCHOOL CURRICULA

To: Regional Directors

- I. With the start of School Year 2010 2011, the adverse effects of the El Niño/La Niña Phenomenon are continually manifested, impinging on the safety and welfare of the general public.
- 2. The country has been experiencing severe damage to agricultural product (crops and livestock), the fishing industry, water and power supplies, public health and other natural disaster.
- 3. There is a need therefore to sustain the awareness campaign and integrate in the School Improvement Plan:
 - a. means to mitigate effects of the El Niño/La Niña Phenomenon in the school level;
 - b. Climate Change Adaptation, Disaster Risk Reduction and Environmental Education to the Elementary and High School curricula;
 - c. encourage the learners to practice basic water and power supply conservation; and
 - d. share the correct, updated information to the family members and to the community folks.
- 4. It is likewise imperative to operationalize the integration of concepts on Climate Change, Disaster Risk Reduction/ Management and Environmental Education into the curricula at all levels.
- 5. To facilitate the effective execution of the program, a seminar cum planning workshop will be held on June 24, 2010 (Thursday) from 8:00 a.m. until 5 p.m. at the Bulwagan ng Karunungan, DepEd Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City, Metro Manila for all Regional Directors to equip them for the continued implementation of the El Niño/La Niña Phenomenon awareness campaign and integration of concepts in their respective regions.
