DEPARTMENT ORDER No. 16, s.1971

USE OF PUBLIC SCHOOL BUILDINGS DESIGNATED BY THE COMMISSION ON ELECTIONS AS POLITING PLACES FOR THE NOVEMBER 8, 1971 FLECTIONS

To The Director of Public Schools,
The Director of Vocational Education, and
The Coordinator of State Colleges and Universities:

- 1. Comformably with the request of the Commission on Elections in Resolution No. 16 dated September 8, 1971, the following instructions are hereby issued for the information and guidance of all concerned.
 - A. To make available all public school buildings throughout the country which have been designated as polling places, in accordance with law, on October 9, 1971 (REGISTRATION DAY); October 23, 1971 (REVISION DAY); and on November 8, 1971 (ELECTION DAY); and also on November 5, 6 and 7, 1971 to allow the construction of voting booths in the school buildings to be used as polling places and to issue appropriate circulars to all division and city superintendents and district supervisors and other school officials concerned to make available those public school buildings on the above stated dates; and
 - B. With respect to the cities of Manila, Quezon, Caloocan and Pasay, to direct the corresponding city superintendents of s schools of the aforementioned cities to circularize to all principals of public high schools and elementary schools, including head teachers or teachers-Incharge of annex school buildings, within their respective jurisdiction to make available the same rooms or premises of public school buildings in the said cities which were used as polling places during the last November 10,1970 election, for use as polling places of the same precients including those additional precincts which have been subsequently created on the same dates mentioned above in connection with the forthcoming November 8, 1971 elections xxx"
 - 2. Immediate dissemination of this Department Order is hereby desired.
