THE LANGUAGE POLICY IN PHILIPPINE EDUCATION

TO: The Director of Public Schools:

Presidents of State Colleges & Universities:

- 1. In response to inquiries from various sectors regarding the lart of instruction in all schools, colleges and diversities in liew of the tion of the 1972 Constitution, the following policy approved by the Nat Board of Education is hereby announced for the information and guidance all concerned:
 - a. Subject to exceptions in special cases as may be determined the Secretary of Education and Culture, the vernacular of the locality shall remain the medium of instruction in Grades I and II with English and Pilipino as subjects.
 - b. English shall be the medium of instruction starting Grade II Pilipino shall be taught as a subject in der to develop the ability to speak, read, and write in this linguage.
 - c. The use of Pilipino as medium of instruction from Grade III up in certain subjects where learning may be facilitated by the use of the said language, may be allowed provided the following conditions are mat: (1) the teacher has the competence to teach in Pilipino; (2) there are adequate teaching materials and, (3) there is readiness in the part of the pupils to learn in Pilipino.

The National Board of Education supports the policy of developinal nation able to communicate in Pilipino as well as in English.

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
