MAXIMIZING THE UTILIZATION OF EDUCATIONAL
RESOURCES AND ENHANCING THE EFFECTIVENESS
OF THE COMMUNITY SCHOOL PROGRAM

To The Director of Public Schools,
The Director of Private Schools,
The Director of Vocational Education and
The Coordinator of State Colleges & Universities:

1. According to projections made by the Presidential Commission to Survey Philippine Education, enrollment at all levels of education will be 12,652,700 in 1974-1975 and 15,287,860 in 1979-1980.

These increases in enrollment will mean additional expenditures for teachers, school buildings, textbooks, instructional materials, and equipment. This will also mean an annual outlay of ₱2.8 Billion in 1974-1975 and ₱3.1 Billion the following year.

2. Since extension positions may not be provided in the national budget next school year and that the only sources of extension positions will be the Special Education Fund of local school boards and the Special Education Stabilization Fund, there will be a problem of accommodating all children of school age.

3. In view of the above, it is imperative for school administrators and teachers to employ strategies calculated to maximize the utilization of existing educational resources to the end that, with reasonable increases in appropriation, the schools can still pursue an effective community school program.

4. It is therefore desired that effective June, 1973, all public elementary classes be organized adhering as closely as possible to a class size of 40-45. Considering that the current teacher-pupil ratio is 1:31, this step will result in considerable reduction in the number of additional teaching positions needed by each division. Not only will there be enough teachers for the new classes but there will also be some teachers who can be released from formal classroom duties to devote their time to more intensive civic action or community development work, work-oriented activities, and cultural, spiritual, moral, physical, and economic development projects and activities.

5. Teachers who are either partially or completely released from classroom work shall be assigned to handle non-formal education activities during their released time, which shall be credited as a legitimate part of their service load. They may schedule these non-formal education activities during regular school periods, or in the evenings, if feasible, and if they so desire. Non-formal education activities shall involve adults and out-of-school youth.

6. A systematic way of assessing teacher service loads shall be adopted by each school to assure equal or comparable teacher loads. A period devoted to any non-formal education activity such as adult and continuing education classes, civic action or community work, manpower development training sessions, scouting, club work, etc., shall be assigned the same weight as a formal class period.

7. The increase in enrolment in the coming years will give rise to a serious problem of school building inadequacy. Since appropriations to provide enough classrooms is limited, there will be a need to adopt measures to help solve this problem.

8. Innovative scheduling of classes offers a possible solution and at the same time brings the advantages of maximizing utilization of classrooms, school grounds, facilities and equipment and of increasing the opportunities for civic action projects, programs and activities thus engendering maximum personal and community development. The Two-Shift Plan described hereunder is recommended.

The Plan requires that all academic subjects be taken up during one session so that the other sessions may be devoted to activities designed to enhance personal and community development.

10. The latter session shall be designated Activity Session. It shall embrace programs, projects and activities for economic, cultural and community development and physical fitness. It shall specifically include activities as Boy and Girl Scouting, vocationally-oriented and culturally-oriented clubs such as Future Farmers, Future Homemakers, glee clubs, etc.; civic action and community development projects; manpower training; and such school subjects as work education, home economics, physical education, practical arts, preparatory military training, and optional religious instruction, which may not be accommodated in the other session. Efforts shall be directed towards achieving a well-balanced Activity Session, embracing activities which shall provide for both personal and community development.

11. The Two-Shift Plan above described will require the revision of class programs. Teachers shall be given leeway to plan out their programs, with the school principals coordinating the revision of schedules so that the maximum utilization of available physical facilities and human resources of the school may be achieved.

12. Flexibility shall be allowed in class program planning. Scheduling may be done in terms of a school day or a week or two to allow bigger blocks of time for specific activities undertaken during the Activity Session. Subjects may be integrated for efficiency and economy in learning. Enclosed are la and lb present prototype classroom programs reflecting the Two-Shift Plan for all elementary grades, some unique classroom arrangements and urban, rural, and barrio secondary schools. Programming in these prototype programs is either by school day or week.

13. In the secondary schools and vocational schools, the Two-Shift Plan lends itself easily to supervised farming projects, cooperative work experience in real life situations and apprenticeship programs where there are industries in the community.

14. The Two-Shift Plan will also help solve the problem of accommodation in barrio high schools as well as of thickly populated schools since more classrooms will be released under this arrangement. Where possible, intermediate classes may be held in the morning so that barrio high school classes can be held in the afternoon.

15. Classes in private elementary and secondary schools shall be scheduled in accordance with their own resources in order to maximize the utilization of their facilities and to provide more opportunities for community development activities for teachers and students, as long as the class sizes are kept within the standards set forth in the Manual of Regulations for Private Schools, 1970 edition.

16. Finally, since the Two-Shift Plan allows a big block of time for integrated activities designed for personal and community development, it holds promise of enhancing the effectiveness of the community school program and ultimately fostering national development.

17. It is desired that the contents of the Department Order be disseminated immediately, and concrete steps be taken to implement the Two-Shft Plan beginning with the school year 1973-1974.



Music and Arts compose one block of 30 minutes. Daily time allotment for each activity may not always be the same, provided that the weekly allotment for Music is 90 minutes and Arts is 60 minutes.

Work Education or Career Oriented Activities and Adult and Continuing Education or Youth and Community Development compose one block of 110 minutes daily. Children, youth, and adult may alternately make their homes and schools as the laboratories of their projects - with adults helping their children in the schools or children helping their parents in the homes during this period, provided that the weekly allotment for Work Education or Career Oriented Activities is 400 minutes.

Character Education, Social Studies, Pilipino and English compose one block of 180 minutes. The daily time allotment for each activity may not always be the same, provided that the weekly allotment for Character Education is 100 minutes; Social Studies 200 minutes; Pilipino 200 minutes; and English 400 minutes.

Health is combined with Physical Education & Scouting. Formal Health lessons shall be recited at least once a week. The daily time allotment for each activity may not be the same, provided that the weekly allotment is 200 minutes.

This is a suggested classroom program in a community where parents ask their children to cook their noon meals, after coming from school.
