REVISED PHYSICAL EDUCATION AND HEALTH, PREPA-RATORY MILITARY TRAINING AND SCOUTING PRO-GRAM IN SECONDARY SCHOOLS

TO: ALL BUREAU DIRECTORS

- 1. Effective the school year 1973-74, the Physical Education and Health, Preparatory Military Training and Scouting Programs in all secondary schools, public and private are hereby revised as follows:
 - a. The Physical Education and Health, Preparatory
 Military Training and Scouting Programs will
 be divided into two areas namely: Youth Development Training and Citizen Army Training I.
 - b. Youth Development Training comprises the Physical Education, Scouting, and Health Education programs for the first, second, and third year students of high schools; with Physical Education taken two days a week, scouting twice a week and Health once a week. All students in these years of high school shall register as boy or girl scouts unless physically disqualified therefrom in which case such students take Physical Education four times a week.
 - c. Citizen Army Training I comprises all fourth year students; boys and girls, who will take a course intended to provide basic citizen army training for one academic year and possibly followed by summer camp training. Details on the summer camp training will be announced later.

- 2. There shall be created in each high school a separate administrative unit or department headed by a well-qualified and competent faculty member who shall take charge of
 administering the Youth Development and Citizen Army Training programs. He shall be designated by the school head in
 consultation with the Superintendent of the ROTC or PMT units
 in the area.
 - 3. Details of courses covered under the Youth Development Training and Citizen Army Training I programs will be issued in separate bulleting.
 - 4. Department Orders No. 4 and 12, s. 1973 are hereby rescinded. Strict compliance herewith is hereby desired.
