

DEPARTMENT ORDER No. 18, s. 1973

REQUIRING THE TEACHING OF THE NEW CONSTITUTION IN ALL SCHOOL'S COLLEGE UNIVERSITIES

To: The Director of Public Schools,
The Director of Private Schools,
The Director of Vocational Education, and
The Coordinator, State Colleges & Universities:

- 1. Section 8(3). Article XV of the New Philippine Constitution provides that "the study of the New Constitution shall be part of the curricula in all schools."
- In pursuance thereto, all schools, colleges and universities, public and private, shall include the teaching of the New Constitution integrated with appropriate subjects in the elementary, secondary levels and/or as a separate subject in the collegiate level beginning the School Yes in 1973-74. If offered as a separate 3-unit course in college, it may either be a replacement of any significant science course or one of the electives required for the course not as an additional load of any existing curricular course in college.
 - The syllabi for the teaching of the New Constitution for each of the three levels shall be prepared by the three Bureau as follows: Bureau of Private Schools, collegiate level, Bureau of Public Schools, elementary level, and Bureau of Vocational Education, secondary level.
 - 4. In view of the proximity of the school opening, it is desired that recommendations from the three bureaus be submitted to this Office as soon as possible.
