THE RATING SYSTEM FOR YDT AND CAT

TO: All Bureau Directors:

In response to inquiries from the field regarding the system of rating to be employed in the Youth Development and Citizens Army Training Courses, the following guidelines are being issued:

1. There shall be only one rating for each course in each grading period.
2. Pending the full implementation of the Revised Secondary Education Program of 1973 the rating for YDT and CAT shall consist of the following:

For YDT

First Semester

40%  
20%

Second Semester

20% of the grade for Scouting  
40% of the grade for Physical  
Education  
20% of the grade for Health  
20% of the grade for Music

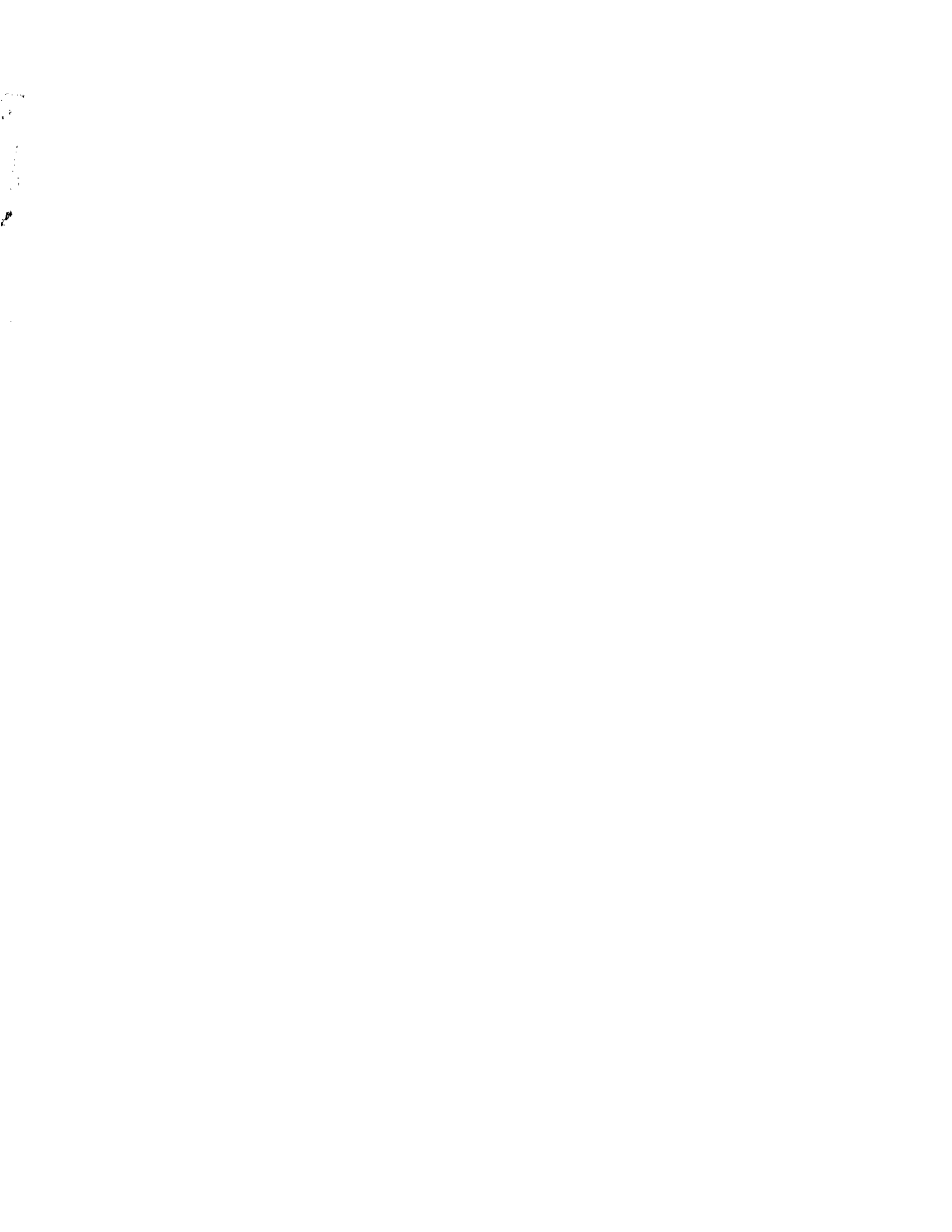

3. In case a student does not obtain a composite passing grade in YDT/CAT due to failure or deficiency in any one of the component subjects of the aforementioned courses, he shall be given a grade of Incomplete in YDT/CAT but







shall be allowed to make-up in the subject in which he failed. Ways of making-up may include the following:

- a. Undertaking additional or supplementary projects.
- b. Performing make-up learning tasks based on the requirements of the courses.
- c. Active participation in activities for the areas of training.
- d. Some such other ways as would enable the student to remove his grade of Incomplete.

In this connection, attention is invited to Inclosure B of Department Order No. 20 s. 1973; Revised Secondary Education Program, 1973, specifically, the description of YDT/CAT courses or subject areas, for guidance in the preparation of possible ways of making-up for any deficiency in any of the component subjects covered by the two courses.

4. This system of rating shall be revised when the integrated approach to the teaching of YDT/CAT shall have been adopted.
5. Immediate dissemination of this information is hereby desired.
