OFFERING OF A THREE-UNIT UNDER-
GRADUATE COURSE IN POPULATION
EDUCATION BEGINNING THE SCHOOL
YEAR 1975-1976

To: All Regional Directors

1. In line with the national policy which considers the population program as an integral and vital part of social reform and economic development, the Department of Education and Culture has launched the implementation of population education in schools.
2. Conformably to its objectives, the Population Education Program has pursued a series of in-service training for elementary and secondary teachers as well as instructors in teacher-training institutions who will take care of the initial needs of the introduction of Population Education in the schools.
3. Considering the magnitude of the population education program, the incorporation of instruction in population education in the curriculum of teacher education at the pre-service level is deemed an important step in the preparation of teachers in program development.
4. Therefore, institutions with faculty members who have receive training in population education from the population Education Program and other similar programs are authorized to offer a three-unit undergraduate course in Population Education starting the ensuing school year 1975-1976.
5. All other educational institutions in the country are enjoined to encourage members of their faculty to undergo proper training in Population Education to maximize the

the teaching of the course which will eventually be made a pre-requisite subject for graduation in all degree and non-degree courses in due time.

6. Preferential attention to this matter is desired.
