EXTENDING THE BENEFITS OF PRESIDENTIAL DECREE
NO. 907 TO HONOR GRADUATES OF SCHOOL YEARS
PRIOR TO 1972-1973

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Coordinator, State Colleges
and Universities

Heads of Private Schools

1. Section 5 of Presidential Decree No. 907 dated March 11, 1976, has been amended by Section 1 of Presidential Decree No. 995 dated September 6, 1976 as follows:

"Section 1. Section 5 of Presidential Decree No. 907 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 5. x x x x x x x x
Honor graduates during the school years previous to 1972-73 shall likewise be conferred civil service eligibilities as provided in Presidential Decree No. 907. They shall, however, register with the Civil Service Commission or any of its regional offices, within six months after the approval of this Decree. The Civil Service Commission shall grant the eligibility in accordance with the rules and regulations promulgated for the purpose."

2. Enclosed are Presidential Decrees No. 907 and No. 995. It is desired that this Department Order and its issuances be given the widest publicity possible in the school divisions.

PROCLAMATION

BY THE PRESIDENT

PROCLAMATIONAL DIRECTIVE NO. 907

GRANTING CERTIFIED SERVICE ELIGIBILITY TO
GRADUATE STUDENTS GRADUATES

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the government to afford every graduate of the university possible opportunity for participation in the development of national endeavor, especially those which tend to the improvement of communities and the welfare of man;

WHEREAS, the present modes of employment in the public service do not fully measure up to prescribed competitive examinations in the determination of merit and fitness; and

WHEREAS, the present law opens the door for adoption of other modes of selection;

WHEREAS, this government is convinced that a student who has graduated from college or university course as a scholar and a good citizen of his school and society, has sufficiently shown himself fit for public service; and

WHEREAS, the public service requires due duties and responsibilities;


WHEREAS, it is considered that graduation with honors in a college or university is a qualifying mark in a student's record of extreme merit and eminence;

WHEREAS, this is a suitable occasion of these honor-graduates to be granted the privilege to assure their participation in the public service and thereby in the welfare of the country;

WHEREAS, the undersigned, FERNANDO E. MARCOS, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby decree:

That all students of universities and colleges and universities of good standing shall be granted the privilege to assure their participation in the public service and the Secretary of Education and Culture shall issue the concerned appropriate civil service

regulations for the same.



Second Grade

Civil Service Eligibility - For those who occupy positions requiring the application of knowledge and skill outside their field of study.

First Grade

Civil Service Eligibility - For those who occupy positions within their respective fields of study.

SECTION 2. Honor graduates shall refer to those students who finish their course with at least cum laude honors.

SECTION 3. The Civil Service eligibility granted under this Decree shall prescribe in the manner provided under Sec. 19 (9) of P.D. No. 807.

SECTION 4. The Civil Service Commission shall promulgate rules and regulations to implement the provisions of this Decree.

SECTION 5. This Decree shall take effect upon its approval provided that honor graduates from the school year 1972-73 and thereafter shall likewise be confirmed eligibilities under this Decree.

PROCLAMATION NUMBER NO. 993
DECLARING THE BENEFITS OF PRESIDENTIAL DECREE
NUMBERED EIGHT HUNDRED SEVEN TO FAVOR GRADUATES
OF SCHOOLS FROM PHIL. NO. 1972-73.

WHEREAS, under Presidential Decree No. 907, I granted Civil Service Eligibility to honor graduates from Philippine Colleges and Universities deemed to be in good standing by the Ministry of Education and Culture to encourage the accomplishment of competent and qualified people in the civil service;

WHEREAS, notwithstanding that this rationale would apply equally to regular public graduates, I have deemed it wise to extend the same to the benefits of the Decree to honor graduates of schools years previous to school year 1972-73,

WHEREAS, I, HERIBERTO L. MAGNIN, M.D., MARCOS, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by the Constitution, do hereby decree and order that:

SECTION 1. Section 5 of Presidential Decree No. 907, shall be amended to read as follows:

"Section 5. * * * * * * * * * *

"Honor graduates during the school years previous to 1972-73 shall likewise be entitled to civil service eligibilities as provided in Presidential Decree No. 907. They shall, however, register with the Civil Service Commission or any of its regional offices, within six months after the effectivity of this Decree. The Civil Service Commission shall grant the eligibility in accordance with the rules and regulations established for this purpose."

SECTION 2. This Decree shall take effect immediately.
