OFFICIAL COMPOSITION OF AN AMATEUR BOXING TEAM AND THE POINTS TO BE AWARDED UNDER THE DEC PHYSICAL FITNESS AND SPORTS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

- 1. In connection with the inclusion of boxing as one of the events in the Department of Education and Culture Physical Fitness and Sports Development Program, beginning the school year 1976-1977, the field is hereby informed that the official composition of an amateur boxing team and the points to be awarded are as follows:
 - a. There will be eight (8) boxers to be fielded by a team which is broken down as follows:
 4 boxers for Group I and 4 boxers for Group II with one coach. Members of the amateur boxing team must come from those who have not participated in any tournament in the town, provincial, regional, and national level sponsored by the Amateur Boxing Association of the Philippines, or any boxing tournament sponsored by commercial firms, civic and religious organizations, athletic clubs, or any professional boxing tournament sponsored by the Games and Amusements Board.
 - b. The individual points for Championships shall be as follows: (Separate championships for each group)

lst place - - - - 5 points 2nd place - - - - 3 points 3rd place - - - - 2 points 4th place - - - - 1 point
