

REQUIRING GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES AUTHORIZED TO TRAVEL ABROAD TO ATTEND A PRE-DEPARTURE ORIENTATION COURSE/SEMINAR

- Nemorandum Circular No. 954, dated January126, 1977, of the Office of the President of the
 Philippines, provides that officials and employees
 of the government and its agencies and instrumentalities, including government-owned or controlled corporations, who are proposed to travel abroad, whether
 on official business or for personal purposes, shall
 first attend a pre-departure orientation course/seminar at the Philippine Center for Advanced Studies
 (PCAS), U.P., Diliman, Quezon City. The aim of the
 orientation course is to equip Filipinos traveling
 abroad with adequate and accurate information about
 their country, especially the goals and workings of
 the New Society and the development strides gained
 under its aegis."
- 2. In this connection, the Department of Foreign Affairs will not issue the corresponding passport unless the applicant presents a certification from PCAS of his having attended said orientation course/seminar.
- J. It is desired that the contents of this Department Order be given as wide publicity as possible in the field.
