UTILIZATION OF TEACHERS PAID FROM NATIONAL FUNDS
IN PRE-ELEMENTARY SCHOOL CLASSES

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents

Pursuant to BPS Memorandum No. 25, s. 1971, encouraging the organization of more pre-elementary education classes in public schools, this Office invites particular attention to its paragraph 6 which states:

"Since no funds are available for the salaries of kindergarten teachers, self-supporting pre-elementary classes may be opened whenever parents are willing to pay a nominal tuition fee for their children and where instructional facilities are available. In no case shall funds from R.A. No. 5447 and/or national allotments be used for these classes."

- 2. Under no circumstances, therefore, should a teacher whose salary-comes from the national government be allowed to teach full time as a pre-elementary school teacher.
- 3. However, teachers paid from national funds may teach preelementary school classes in addition to their service load as regular teachers and may be given honorarium/remuneration for such services.
- 4. Other alternatives for organizing classes and giving compensation to pre-elementary school teachers may be explored, provided the basic guidelines cited above are given prior consideration.
- 5. Immediate dissemination of the contents of this Department. Order is hereby desired.
