DEPARTMENT ORDER
No. 56, s. 1977

AUTHORITY FOR THE OPERATION OF COURSES IN
PUBLIC AND OTHER GOVERNMENT-RUN SCHOOLS

To:

Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents

1. Effective immediately, the practice of issuing authority for the operation of courses in public and other government-run schools by simple indorsement or letter only shall be stopped.
2. Henceforth, public and other government-run schools, except chartered colleges and universities, shall be issued permit, renewal permit, and/or recognition on the regular certificate form with serial numbers indicated thereon.
3. The permit and recognition certificate forms generally used in authorizing courses in private schools shall be adopted, but modified accordingly by deleting the words applicable only to private schools.
4. As usual, a permit is issued to authorize a new course or an additional curriculum year thereof and shall cover a period of one year or one school year, as the case may be, while a renewal permit is issued to extend for another year/school year the previous permit issued. A recognition shall be issued after at least one year of operation of a course under satisfactory standards. It is a permanent authority which shall remain in force until otherwise cancelled or revoked.

5. The provisions of Department Orders Nos. 22 and 60, s. 1975, on the functions delegated to regional directors and those retained by the Secretary of Education and Culture on the grant of permit, renewal permit, and recognition shall be observed.

6. This Department Order shall take effect immediately. Strict compliance by all concerned is desired.
