REQUIREMENT OF TAXATION AND AGRARIAN REFORM FOR COMMERCE AND BUSINESS EDUCATION STUDENTS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Coordinator, State Colleges and Universities
Headsof Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

- Department Order No. 10, s. 1978, specifies that all college students are required to complete three units of Taxation and Agrarian Reform as a pre-requisite for graduation beginning the current school Reform as a pre-requisite for graduation beginning the subject as year (1978-1979), except those students who have taken the subject as a one-unit or integrated course offering before or during the summer session of 1978.
- 2. The curriculum for the degree of Bachelor of Science in Commerce/Business Administration, in all major fields of concentration, requires six (6) units of Taxation. Effective immediately Tax Consciousness should be made a part of this course on taxation.
- 3. Students who have completed six units of Taxation in the Commerce and/or Business Curriculum are exempted from the requirement of Department Order No. 10, s. 1978, provided they take up Agrarian Reform either as a one-unit subject or integrated with any other Social Science course, and provided further that at least 18 hours are devoted to Agrarian Reform.
- 4. Immediate dissemination of the provisions of this MEC Order is desired.
