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- 2. These prices will be applied to EDPITAF books distributed under the following categories:
 - a. Mass Pupils' Text textbooks falling under this category are those which are intended and distributed at a 1:2 book pupil ratio for use of students.
 - b. Astrition Volume textbooks falling under this category are those which are distributed to division and regional warehouses to cover shortages in allotment, lost or destroyed books and increases in enrolment. Usually this corresponds to 8.75% of the mass pupils' ellotment distributed yearly. Attrition copies should be kept in division warehouses for additional copies on a case to case basis. However, when a school or district is not included in the master list covering mass pupils' distribution and therefore is not allotted any copy, attrition volume can be utilized as mass pupils texts and reports/information should be submitted to TBS-EDPITAF for replacement. Attrition copies sent to regional warehouse should be distributed to their service areas for acknowledgment by the division superintendents and supply officers concerned.
