> CLARIFICATION ON SEC. 6 OF RULE II OF MEC ORDER NO. 19, S. 1979

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
School Superintendents
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges
and Universities

1. Sec. 6 of Rule II of MEC Order No. 19, s. 1979 should be taken and appreciated in relation to Sec. 5 of the same Rule which is the basis thereof. The intent and purpose of Sec. 6 on Disqualification is to assure that the incremental proceeds as may be derived from the approved increase in tuition and other school fees for the school year 1979-80, including those for the school years 1977-78 and 1978-79, would be devoted entirely for the purposes embodied in Sec. 2 of Rule I of said Order.

2. Accordingly, Section 6 of Rule II of said MEC Order is hereby integrated with Section 5 thereof and is deemed amended as follows:

Sec. 5. No portion of the incremental proceeds from the approved increase of tuition and other school fees of private schools for the school year 1979-80, including those for the school years 1977-78 and 1978-79, as may be applicable, shall be used for the payment of dividends or distribution of profit.

Neither shall any part of such proceeds be used for the payment or increase of the compensation or benefits of members of the governing boards who are duly appointed or designated to serve in administrative positions in a private school; nor shall such proceeds or any part thereof be disbursed for any purpose not germane to the provisions of Sec. 2 of Rule I of MEC Order No. 19, s. 1979.
