REVISED RULES ON THE EXEMPTION OF SCOUTS FROM CITIZEN  
ARMY TRAINING (CAT) AND BASIC PHYSICAL  
EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Schools Superintendents

1. The revised rules on the exemptions of scouts from Citizen Army Training (CAT) and from the Basic Physical Education requirements are given below, for the information and guidance of all concerned:
  - a. Scouts who are 4th year high school students and who have attained the Service Badge or formerly First Class rank or who have participated in recognized scouting events overseas, may be exempted from Citizen Army Training (CAT) upon recommendation of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines (BSP) regional service centers and approval of the MEC regional director concerned.
  - b. Scouts who are post-secondary education (college) students who have attained the Service Badge or any award above this or who have participated in recognized scouting events overseas, may also be considered for exemption from the Basic Physical Education requirements, likewise upon the recommendation of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines regional service centers and approval of the MEC regional director concerned.
2. Authorizing the Boy Scouts of the Philippines regional centers to act on applications of scouts for exemption in behalf of the BSP National Headquarters will simplify the process of verifying and certifying the qualifications of scout-applicants.







3. The attached forms should be used in applying for exemption. Copies may be produced by BSP Local Council or BSP regional service centers and furnished to interested parties.

4. Immediate dissemination of the contents of this MEC Order is desired.

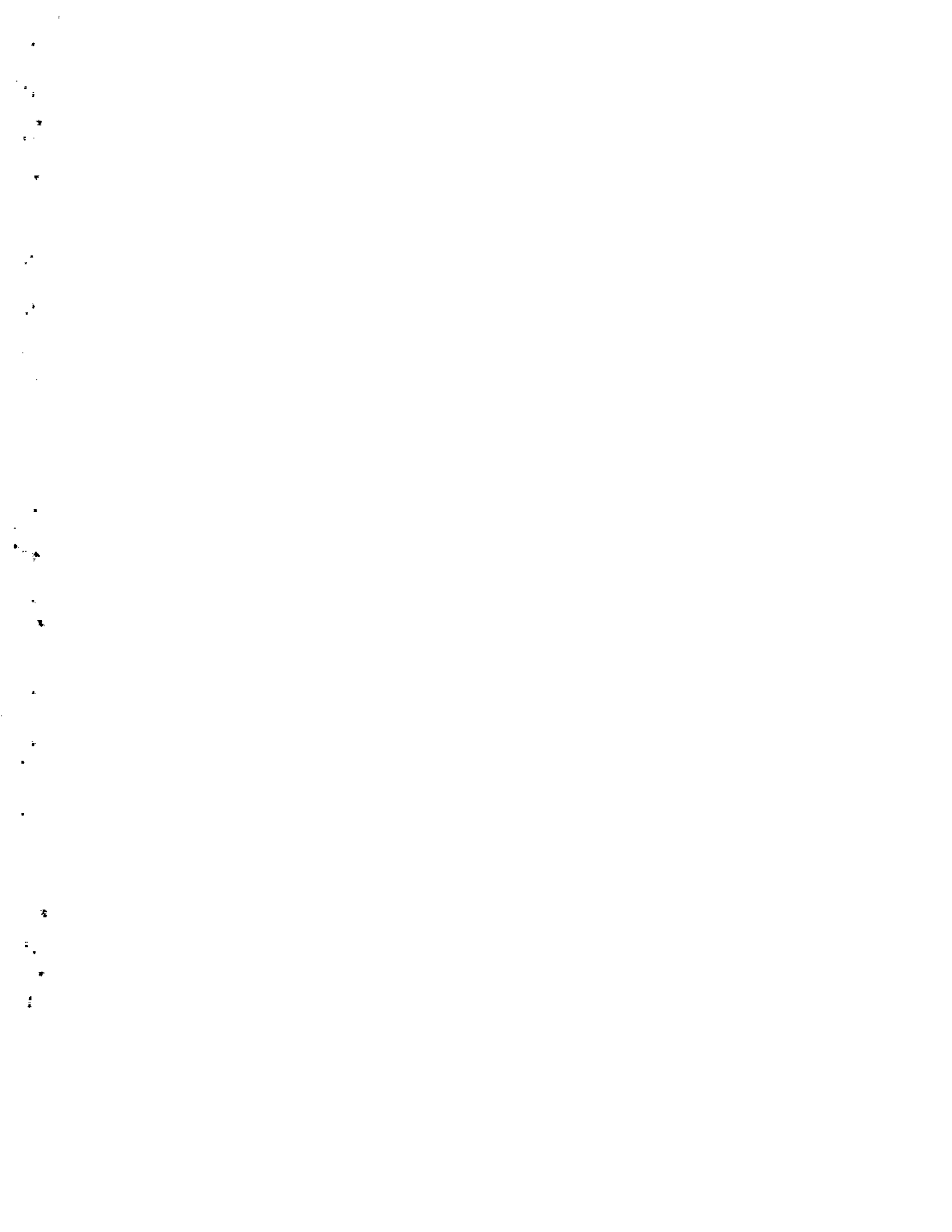
