NATIONAL BUDGET CIRCULAR NO. 313 August 16, 1979

To:

Heads of Ministries, Eureaus, Offices and Agencies of the National Government, Governing Boards of Government-Owned and/or -Controlled Corporations, and All Others Concerned

Subject: MINIMUM WAGE FOR NATIONAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES INCLUDING THOSE IN GOVERNMENT-OWNED AND/OR -CONTROLLED CORPORATIONS

1.6 Purpose. This Circular is being issued in compliance with Letter of Implementation No. 21 dated August 9, 1979, increasing the minimum wage of all national government employees, including those in government-owned and/or -controlled corporations to Thirteen Pesos (713) per day or Three Hundred Ninety Pesos (7390) per month or Four Thousand Six Hundred Eighty Pesos (74,680) per annum provided under Presidential Decree No. 15 effective May 1, 1979.

2.0 Coverage

- 2.1 This Circular shall apply to all full-time employees of the Na tional Government including those in government-owned and/or -controlled corporations, whether permanent, temporary, emrgency or casual, and wheth their positions are covered by the national compensation and classificati plans or by special salary plans.
- 2.2 This Circular may, likewise, apply to employees of the local government, subject to the availability of local funds and as the Joint Commission on Local Government Personnel Administration may authorize.
 - 3.0 Definitions
- 3.1 For purpose of this Circular, full-time employees shall mean those, who, by the terms of their appointments, are required to observe the regular working hours prescribed by law for government employees consisting of at least 8 hours per day on a 5-day work week.
- 3.2 The actual salary of an employee shall mean the total compensation received by an employee as of May 1, 1979 which includes his basic salary as of April 30, 1979, the salary increases as a result of the salar range upgrading and percentage adjustments pursuant to the provisions of National Budget Circular Nos. 305 and 307, and emergency cost of living allowance, but excluding subsistence, clothing, laundry, quarters, and similar allowances being received by the employee.

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4.0 Implementing Pules

4.1 National Government Employees:

- 4.1.1 If the actual salary of an employee as defined under Item 3.2 is less than \$13 per day or \$390 per month or \$4,680 per annum, his wage or salary shall be increased to \$13 daily, \$390 monthly or \$4,680 per annum, respectively, whichever is applicable, effective May 1, 1979.
- 4.1.2 The emergency cost of living allowance being received by the employee, if any, shall be integrated as part of the basic salary of the employee before the increase authorized herein is granted. Henceforth, no payment for emergency cost of living allowance shall be authorized.
- 4.1.3 Effective May 1, 1979, the minimum wage to be prescribed on all appointments shall be \$13 per day or \$290 per month or \$4,680 per annum, whichever is applicable.
- 4.2 The Head of the Ministry, Bureau, Regional Office, Agency, or government corporation shall notify the employee concerned of his adjusted salary through a Notice of Salary Increase prescribed herein, and attached as Annex A. A copy of the Notice of Salary Increase shall be furnished the GSIS, if the beneficiary is a member thereof.
- 4.3 For economy and to facilitate issuance, this Notice of Salary Increase may be issued in the form of a Special Order to include employees having similar data and information such as designation, salary range and actual basic salary. A sample form is attached as Annex B.

5.0 Funding Source

- 5.1 The amounts appropriated for salary increases which are incorporated in the budgets of national government offices shall be used to implement the salary increase authorized under this Circular.
- 5.2 Salary lapses and other personal services savings of the ministry/bureau/office/agency concerned shall be used first to cover any deficiency in the amount needed for the herein provided salary increase.
- 5.3 Any remaining deficiency in the amounts needed herein for salary increase shall be covered by the Salary Adjustment Fund in the 1979 General Appropriations Act and from budgetary reserves, with the approval of the Minister of the Budget.
- 5.4 Funding from Item 5.2 shall be resorted to only if the funding source under Item 5.1 is already exhausted; similarly, funding from Item 5.3 shall be resorted to only if the funding source under Item 5.2 is already exhausted.
- 5.5 No action shall be subsequently taken on the use of personal services savings for agencies which are authorized to draw against the Salary Adjustment Fund.

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5.6 The increase in ririmum wage/salary herein authorized for employees in government-owned and/or -controlled corporations being paid from funds other than the General Fund, shall be charged against their respective appropriations or corporate funds.

6.0 Payment and Allotment and Accounting Procedures

- 6.1 The salary increase authorized in this Circular may be paid even prior to the receipt by the Agency of the Advice of Allotment from the Ministry of the Budget. The Cash Disbursement Ceiling for the purpose shall be issued by the Ministry of the Budget even prior to the release of said Advice of Allotment, provided that the request shall be supported by a duly accomplished statement showing that the amount required cannot be covered from the Cash Disbursement Ceiling already allowed to the Agency on the basis of its regular allotments.
- 6.2 The Accounting Officer of each Ministry, Rureau, Regional Office, Office, Agency or other entity of the National Government shall accomplish and submit to the Ministry of the Rudget not later than fifteen (15) days after the end of the preceding month, a statement of actual payments of the minimum wage/salary increase made during the preceding month duly certified in accordance with the prescribed form attached as Annex C, on the basis of which the Advice of Allotment for the purpose shall be issued by the Ministry of the Budget.
- 7.0 Responsibility of the Head of Agency. The head of the agency or corporation concerned shall be held personally liable for any payment of the minimum wage/salary increase (made) granted which is not in accordance with this Circular, and for the non-submission of the required reports, without prejudice, however, to the refund of any excess payment by the employee/employees concerned.
- 8.0 Contribution to GSIS. The salary increase herein authorized is subject to the mandatory requirements of GSIS life and retirement insurance premiums if the recipient is a member thereof.
- 9.0 Saving Clause. Cases not covered by the provisions of this Circular shall be referred to the Minister of the Budget for appropriate action and/or recommendation.
- 10.0 Effectivity of Minimum Wage/Salary Increase. The minimum wage/salary increase provided herein shall take effect May 1, 1979.
