PROHIBITING TRANSFER OF TEACHERS ITEMS FROM REMOTE, DEPRESSED OF TROUBLED AREAS TO STABLE AND PROSPEROUS AREAS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities

- 1. This Office has observed that teachers items in remote, depressed, or troubled areas are often transferred to districts or divisions that are generally prosperous or stable, through the medium of teachers transferring from the former to the latter assignments, and carrying their items.
- 2. This practice is contrary to justice and to the New Society policy of priority to poor and deprived areas. It makes poor, remote, and troubled areas the source of teachers items for stable, prosperous, and comfortable areas.
- 3. Effective immediately, the transfer of teachers items from barrios and municipalities, especially where poverty, calamity, and disturbed peace and order conditions are manifest, is hereby prohibited.
- 4. Strict compliance with this Order is desired,
