- In view of the need to observe economy in government operations ad specifically as a measure to conserve precious resources so as to enable this Ministry to maintain present levels of service capability despite the new fuel cost increases, it has been decided to suspend the 1980 Palarong Pambansa scheduled to be held on March 15-22, 1980, at Tuguegarao, Cagayan, and the State Colleges and Universities Athletic Association (SCUAA) Meet scheduled for March 1-7, 1980, at the Isahela State University, Echague, Isabela.
- 2. With this and earlier iscuances of this Office i.e., Office Order dated February 0, 1980, copy inclosed, and MEC Order No. 8, s. 1980 on the subject, as well as additional policy moves that new developments in the present energy crisis cituation may warrant to be taken, it should become possible for this Ministry to continue giving maximum service within present budgetary resources and without necessitating a fresh infusion of funds.
- 3. It is expected that the Palarong Pambansa will be resumed in 1981, at which time the site or venue will be in Region II, Tuguegarao, Cagayan.
- 4. Likewise, the Isabela State University, Echague, Isabela, will be the venue of the SCUAA games in 1981.
- 5. It is emphasized, in this connection, that the regional meets shall continue as scheduled.
- Immediate dissemination of this Order is enjoined.

ALL-OUT COST CUTTING EFFORT

To: All MEC Personnel

- 1. In the joint Cabinet-NEDA Board meeting which was presided over by the President last 4 February, it was accepted that the country's resources will be under enormous pressure this year lue to cost and price increases.
- 2. For instance, we used to pay \$1.30 per barrel of oil in 1970; today we are paying almost \$30 per barrel. In 1979, the covernment subsidized oil and related fuel prices at the rate of 13 million everyday, in order to lower prices paid by consumers. Due to the latest increases, the government subsidy is now 117 million per day.
- 3. A bright development is that, from zero production in 1964, the Philippines produced 17% of our total oil requirements last year. By later this year we can produce at a rate of 25% of our oil needs.
- Nevertheless, we must lead the country in husbanding and conserving our resources. Indeed, the President believes that we cannot ask our people to undergo sacrifices that we ourselves will not make.
- 5. So, for your information, I am considering the following cost-cutting measures as general policies:
 - a. No new positions will be created.
 - b. Vacant positions will not be filled.
 - c. No motor vehicles will be purchased.
 - d. Equipment such as garden tools and the like will not be procured.
 - e. Travel will be reduced to the minimum.
 - f. Seminars, workshops, live-in training programs, etc., will be rigidly screened.
 - g. Energy consumption will be reduced. The rate of reduction will be established later next week.
 - h. Operation of MEC motor vehicles will be controlled through a trip ticket system, and there will be a "curfew" hour on motor vehicle use.

6. The Office of the Minister will finalize the measures next week. In the meantime, I invite your cooperation in the spirit of savings. If you have any suggestions, please send them to my Office.
