AMENDING THE QUOTA SYSTEM FOR FOREIGN NON-RESIDENT AND FOREIGN PERMANENT RESIDENT STUDENTS IN MEDICAL AND DENTAL COURSES

- 1. Paragraphs 4(a) and (b) of MEC Order No. 74, s. 1979, entitled "Revised Quota of Foreign Students in the Philippines," is hereby amended as follows:
 - a. The initial five per cent (5%) quota for foreign freshman students is for all foreign students, non-resident or permanent resident. In other words, this is not reserved for foreign non-resident freshmen. Non-residents and permanent residents will compete for placement within this initial five per cent.
 - b. However, if after this initial five per cent is filled, there are still permanent resident freshman applicants, a second five per cent (5%) quota shall be allowed for permanent residents only.
- 2. In brief, the total number of foreign freshman students, non-resident and permanent resident, in each medical or dental school shall be five per cent (5%); but additional foreign freshman applicants who are permanent residents may be admitted up to a maximum of another five per cent (5%).
