AMENDING CERTAIN FORTIONS OF LEC ORDER NO. 32, S. 1978 REGARDING ELIGIDILITY OF ATHLETES

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents of State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

- l. Protest on eligibility of athletes shall be done in writing and submitted to the Chairman of the Screening Committee by the head of delegation duly supported with authentic documents within two (2) hours after the termination of the game of the player's team being protested. The Screening Committee shall convene immediately and decide on the merits of the eligibility protest and make a decision within sim (5) hours after acceptance of the protest which shall be final, irrevocable and executory.
- 2. After a decision has been made that an ineligible player was made to play, the team with such player shall be declared to have lost the game and the opponent team shall automatically become winner. The erring team shall be debarred from further playing throughout the duration of the meet. However, results of previous games of the debarred team shall be honored and recognized.
- 3. Any person who is found responsible in allowing ineligible players in a team to play in all athletic meets sponsored by the MEC shall be suspended from athletic meets throughout his life, without prejudice to the filing of administrative charges against him even after the athletic meet is over.
- 4. All previous regulations inconsistent with this MEC Order are rescinded.
- 5. This MEC Order takes effect immediately.
