ABOLISHING THE NATIONAL YCAP COORDINATING CENTER

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units  
Schools Superintendents  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities  
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. In line with the policy of this Ministry for simplicity, economy and effectiveness of operations, this Office, in Office Order dated November 3, 1980, directed the transfer of the administration and coordination of YCAP activities to the regional offices.
2. Accordingly, the YCAP Coordinating Center is abolished and the following activities, among others, shall be implemented immediately:
  - a. YCAP at the elementary and secondary levels shall be integrated in the appropriate curriculum offerings at each level effective the school year 1980-81. At the tertiary level in non-chartered government institutions, YCAP shall likewise be integrated in the curriculum requirements where appropriate, effective at the earliest possible time. Private tertiary level institutions shall effect such measures relative to YCAP in order to comply with the requirements of law and regulation.
  - b. No YCAP fees for whatever purpose shall be collected from elementary and secondary school pupils/students.
  - c. The members of the YCAP Coordinating Center who have worked on detail basis in the unit shall return to their mother units which, wherever possible, shall utilize their expertise.
3. The Administrative Service and the Financial and Management Service were directed to take over and assume possession of and responsibility for all the records, equipment/properties, and funds/appropriations respectively of the National YCAP Coordinating Center until their final disposition by this Office.

4. In view of the importance of the YCAP, the entire program shall be coordinated in the Office of the Minister of Education and Culture, through Deputy Minister Hermenegildo C. Dumlao, who shall report thereon to the Minister.
5. The Ministry will continue to discharge its commitments with other agencies in accordance with the foregoing provisions.
6. This Order supersedes and rescinds all other directives regarding the organization and operations of the National YCAP Coordinating Center and shall take effect immediately.
7. Immediate dissemination of this Order is desired.
