SCHOOL CALENDAR DURING PRESIDENTIAL
ELECTION YEARS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Cultural Agency Directors
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units

Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and
Universities

1. In view of the fact that 16 June 1981 has been fixed by law as the date of the presidential elections, and 30 June being fixed in the Constitution, as amended, as the date for the oath-taking of the President-elect, and in order to avoid imposing unnecessary expenses on students who study in towns or cities other than those where they are registered voters, the first day of classes during the school year 1981-1982 is hereby fixed as 22 June 1981.
2. No school, college, or university shall begin classes earlier than said date.
3. Every school, college, or university is enjoined to adjust their school calendars consistently with the above. Any adjustment in conformity herewith is hereby authorized by this Ministry.
