SUBJECT: Guidelines Governing Appointments Covered by Resolution No. 1504 of the Commission on Elections Fromulgated on April 24, 1981

In observance of the prohibitions covering appointments and other personnel actions prescribed in Section 178 of the Revised Election Code of 1978 as implemented in Resolution No. 1504 of the Commission on Elections in the June 16, 1981 Presidential Elections, the following guidelines are hereby promulgated:

- 1. The prohibited period shall be from May 4 to June 16, 1981.
- 2. If the date of issue, effectivity and/or receipt of an appointment as appearing on the face thereof is within the period, said appointment shall be returned by the Civil Service Commission to the agency concerned without action inviting attention to the Resolution of the Commission on Elections.
- 3. The following are prohibited:
 - a. Appointment or hiring of any new employee, whether provisional, temporary or casual
 - b. Creation and filling of new positions except upon prior authority of the Commission on Elections in both cases (A and B).
- 4. No detail or transfer whatsoever of any officer or employee in the Civil Service including public school teachers within the election period shall be made except upon prior written approval of the Commission on Elections.
- 5. The agency concerned shall take the initiative of securing the authority mentioned above.
- 6. The foregoing appointments are considered null and void. The appointee, therefore, should not be paid his salary and his claim should not be

allowed in audit by the authorities concerned. In view thereof, there is, therefore, a need to issue a new appointment for the appointee effective after the election period.

This Memorandum Circular shall take effect immediately.
