REDEFINING THE YOUTH CIVIC ACTION PROGRAM (YCAP)

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. Effective immediately, the Youth Civic Action Program (YCAP), a curricular requirement for graduation in all educational levels, shall be limited to activities in support of the following government programs:
(a) civic welfare service component of the National Service Law (PD. 1706);
(b) Kilusang Kabuhayan At Kaunlaran or KKK (EO 715); and (c) Citizens' Tree-planting (PD 1153).

2. Each school shall adopt a barangay to serve as its YCAP Laboratory for a minimum period of one year.

3. Conformably to existing memorandum of agreements it is suggested that an interim National Youth Service Council (NYSC) be organized composed of the heads or representatives of the signatory agencies to the agreements as follows: KKK National Secretariat, Bureau of Forest Development, Bureau of Animal Industry, Ministry of National Defense, NEDA Agriculture Staff, Budget and Management Office, Office of Media Affairs and National Youth Service Council Secretariat. Deputy Minister Hermenegildo C. Dumlao is hereby authorized to coordinate the immediate formation of such a body. The Council will serve as the steering committee for purposes of the implementation of the YCAP and issue operational guidelines from time to time.

Immediate compliance with this Order is desired.
