SUBMISSION OF SUPPLEMENTARY PROCUREMENT PROGRAMS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
School Superintendents
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. In order to achieve a more economical, effective and efficient procurement system, this Office hereby promulgates and institutes an Overall Procurement Program consisting of two parts. Part I is the Division Procurement Program now being submitted annually by each School Division through the MEC Regional Office to this Office, covering items procured from Division funds. Part II which is hereby required, is the Supplementary (Central) Procurement Program, which shall cover supply requirements of each School Division which are not funded locally and are procured for distribution to the various School Divisions by the General Office.
2. Parts I and II shall be prepared by each School Division Office, using the same form as the present Annual Procurement Program, but clearly and separately identifying the Supplementary (Central) Procurement Program. The items to be procured under Part II must be listed by priority. Both Programs shall be submitted to the MEC Regional Office, which shall review them and then forward the same to this Office.
3. The MEC Regional Offices shall transmit all programs to the Central Office not later than October 15 immediately preceding the ensuing Calendar Year covered by the Program.
4. Supplementary (Central) Procurement Programs submitted pursuant to this Order shall be reviewed by the MEC Procurement Committee which shall draw up the overall Annual Procurement Program to be submitted to the Minister for his approval. Once approved, this Annual Procurement Program shall be the basis of purchases to be made.
5. This MEC Order takes effect immediately.
