THE THREE-TPACK PROGRAMS IN TEACHER EDUCATION AND CLARIFICATION
ON THE ITEP CURRICULUM

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. In view of new MEC educational improvement programs and curricular considerations, this Office is hereby announcing that effective school year 1982-1983, the teacher education programs shall be as follows: Bachelor of Elementary Education (B.E.Ed.), Bachelor of Secondary Education (B.S.Ed.), and Bachelor of Pedagogy (B.Ped.).
2. The bachelor of Elementary Education is designed for students who plan to teach in the elementary schools; the Bachelor of Secondary Education is for students who wish to teach in secondary schools; and the Bachelor of Pedagogy is for those students who will go to scholarly work or research and other related non-teaching educational activities.
 - a. Beginning school year 1982-83, the present Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education (B.S.E.Ed.) curriculum shall be called "Bachelor of Elementary Education (B.E.Ed.)".
 - b. the present Bachelor of Science in Education shall be called "Bachelor of Secondary Education (B.S.Ed.)";
 - c. the curriculum requirements for the Bachelor of Pedagogy (B.Ped.) will be announced in due time.
3. The on-going experimental Integrated Teacher-Education Program (ITEP) may continue until students who have enrolled in the program in the participating schools during the school years 1980-81 and 1981-82 shall have graduated. Participating institutions shall desist from accepting new enrollees under the program beginning the school year 1982-83, and that the experiment shall be limited to the classes which have been organized during the school years 1980-81 and 1981-82.
4. Graduates of the ITEP curriculum may apply for graduation for either a Bachelor of Elementary Education (B.E.Ed.) or Bachelor of Secondary Education (B.S.Ed) degree, with a certification to be issued by

the institution concerned that the student has satisfactorily completed all the requirements for teaching in both the elementary and secondary levels.

5. Effective school year 1985-86, new appointments to elementary school teaching positions shall be limited to holders of B.E.Ed. degree and for secondary teaching positions, holders of the R.S.Ed. degree.

6. It is desired that the contents of this Order be immediately disseminated for the information of all those concerned.
