GUIDELINES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE FEES
AND APPLICATIONS OF TUITION AND OTHER SCHOOL
FEES FOR THE SCHOOL YEAR 1982-1983

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The applicability of MFC Order No. 21, s. 1980, as amended by MFC Order No. 33, s. 1981, is hereby extended to the school year 1982-1983, with the following further amendments:

a. Sub-paragraph 5.4 is further amended to read as follows:

5.4. Notwithstanding any of the foregoing provisions of this Order, a school or institution may apply to the MFC for "de-regulated status" insofar as school fee increases are concerned. De-regulated status may be applied for by a school or institution for any or all of its programs, provided that the institution grants a reasonable amount of financial resources to scholarships or similar assistance to financially needy students. Applications under this provision shall be filed by the head of the school or institution on or before August 30, 1982, supporting the application with a statement under oath (a) that prior consultations/dialogues with the parents/students on the need for school fee increases under de-regulated status have been made and that the rates of fees collected are accepted or concurred in by at least 85 percent of the students (in cases of pre-collegiate programs, by the parents through payment of the fees involved), (b) of the amount of the institutional resources set aside or budgeted to be awarded as student assistance for the current year and (c) of the fee rates collected in each of the programs relative to which de-regulation is applied for. The amount budgeted for student assistance shall be actually awarded to and enjoyed by student beneficiaries as a condition of approval by the MFC.

The MEC Regional Director concerned shall process applications for school fee increases under de-regulated status and submit the applications with his recommendations to the Minister of Education and Culture within sixty days from the date of filing in the regional office.

- b. The school years referred to in sub-paragraphs 3.1, 3.4 and 3.6 and in paragraph 4 shall be 1981-1982. The school year mentioned in sub-paragraphs 3.3 and 5.1 shall be 1982-1983. In sub-paragraph 5.1, the date after the phrase "improved physical facilities completed and in use before . . ." in the first sentence shall be June 30, 1982, and the year in the phrase "started not earlier than . . ." in the third sentence shall be 1981.
- c. The deadline for filing applications referred to in sub-paragraph 3.3 shall be August 7, 1982, and that in sub-paragraph 5.1, July 15, 1982.

2. The report called for in paragraph 3 of MEC Order No. 33, s. 1981, shall be for 1982-1983 and submitted to the Chairman, School Fees Task Force, MEC, on or before December 15, 1982.

3. Please be guided accordingly.
