LAUNCHING OF THE NEW ELEMENTARY SCHOOL CURRICULUM (NESC)

- 1. The New Elementary School Curriculum (NESC) which is due for implementation starting this school year 1983-1984, will be formally launched at the Plenary Hall, Philippine International Convention Center (PICC) on June 3, 1983 at 10 o'clock in the morning.  - g. 2603 NCR Principals and Teachers
 - h. 500 Principals and Teachers from Cavite and Laguna

 - j. 90 other Guests, Media Representatives, etc.

- 4. Expenses incidental to the attendance in the launching of the NESC is chargeable against local funds.
- 5. General Office (MECS) officials are also expected to attend. However, a skeleton force will be designated to man the offices and to conduct official business as usual.
