REVISED SYSTEM OF RATING AND REPORTING
OF PUPIL PROGRESS

To: Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. Effective this school year 1983-84, a more simplified system of rating and reporting pupil progress in the elementary grades shall be used. Accordingly, a set of simplified forms has been devised. The simplification of the forms, minimizing the recording job of teachers, is designed to enable teachers to spend more time in helping children progress in their schoolwork.

2. Inclosed are guidelines on the new system and samples of the new records, as follows:

- a. Suggested Procedure for Rating and Reporting Pupil Progress
- b. Criteria for the Different Learning Areas in the New Elementary School Curriculum (1982)
- c. Criteria for the Different Subject Areas in the 1970 Revised Curriculum
- d. Pupil's Permanent Record (MEC Form 137-E)
- e. Pupil's Report Card (MEC Form 138-E)

3. This Office would appreciate comments and/or reactions from the field on the suggested procedures and forms.

4. This Order supersedes BPS Circular No. 2, s. 1973 and BPS Memorandum No. 25, s. 1973.

SUGGESTED PROCEDURE FOR RATING PERFORMANCE
AND REPORTING PUPIL PROGRESS

The system of rating and reporting individual pupil progress in the New Elementary School Curriculum is based on a continuum of learning expectancies.

The following steps are suggested for rating the pupil's performance:

1. To determine pupil's achievement, give summative tests such as paper-and-pencil tests, performance tests, and other measures of non-cognitive behavior, like checklists, rating scales and observation techniques.
2. Keep a Class Progress Record Form in which the results of summative tests for each of the criteria in every learning area are to be recorded. It will be noted that the sixth criterion in each learning area is about character development. The indicators used in rating character traits that are listed in the Pupil's Card (MECS Form 138-E and Permanent Record (MECS Form 137-E) shall likewise be entered in the Class Progress Record Form. The list of criteria for each learning area as well as the character trait indicators are all found in Inclosure No. 2. For the grades still using the 1970 curriculum, the criteria are listed in Inclosure No. 3.
3. Convert the raw scores which the pupils obtain in a given summative measure or test into their equivalent ratings in accordance with the given transmutation formula:

$$RS \times \frac{50}{N} + 50 = R$$

Where RS = Raw Score
N = No. of Items in the Test
R = Equivalent Transmuted Rating

(A sample transmutation table entitled "Equivalent Ratings of Test Scores" is inclosed for the convenience of teachers.)

4. At the end of each grading period, the average of scores in the different summative tests or measures, either cognitive or non-cognitive, under each broad objective or criterion in the given subject or learning area shall be computed and rounded off to the nearest multiple of 5. Get the sum of the averages of each of the six criteria in each subject and divide this by 6. The obtained average which shall not be rounded off to the nearest multiple of 5 shall be entered in the report card as the pupil's grade for the given subject.

Ratings with a decimal fraction of .5 and above shall be rounded off to the next higher number.

e.g. - English

5. The rating of 83 in English shall be entered in the card accordingly. Ratings below 75 are failing. All efforts, shall however be extended to help the pupil improve his performance. If all possible assistance has been extended and still no improvement is noted, the pupil may be assigned a failing grade of 65 or 70. Evidences of assistance given to a slow learner should be recorded in Form I and in the remarks in MECS Form 138-E (Pupil's Report Card). The parents of the pupil should be invited to a conference by the teacher who shall explain about the efforts done by the school and the reasons for the pupil's inability to cope with the work in the grade.
6. Character Building Activities shall not be graded as a learning area in the NESO since a criterion on character is already included in each of the

learning areas (See Inclosure No. 2). The pupil's progress in character development shall however be reported in the pupils card. All teachers teaching the class shall mark the pupil's on these character traits, using the indicators listed in Inclosure No. 2, as bases. The average scores/ results of observation measures made by the teacher or by the different teachers, if several did rate the pupils for each trait, is converted into a descriptive rating represented by a letter symbol. This letter symbol shall be reported in the pupil's card. The scale for rating is given below.

<u>Descriptive Scale</u>	<u>Letter Symbol</u>	<u>Range of Scores</u>
Outstanding	A	90 and above
Very Satisfactory	B	82 - 89
Satisfactory	C	75 - 81
Needs Improvement	D	Below 75

7. Enter the rating for each learning area in the report card (MECS Form 138-E) for every grading period. At the end of the school year, compute the average of the grades for the 4 rating periods in each subject area and enter it under Final Rating in MECS Form 138-E. The general average of the pupil will be based on the average of all subject areas obtained under Final Rating. A pupil who gets a general average of below 75 shall be retained in the grade.
8. At the end of each rating period, the subjects or learning areas and the pupil's marks corresponding to each shall also be entered in the Elementary School Permanent Record (MECS Form 137-E).
9. The report on promotions for Grades I-III (MECS Form 18-E-1) and for Grades IV-VI (MECS Form 18-E-2) inclosed with MEC Order No. 25, s. 1978 shall be accomplished accordingly at the end of the school year.
