GUIDELINES FOR THE HIRING OF SUBSTITUTE TEACHERS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

- 1. In connection with the employment of substitute teachers this Office hereby issues the following guidelines as bases:
 - a. Schools that will be given priority:
 - Small schools (one-or-two-teacher schools) which would close if not given substitute teachers
 - (2) Schools whose school boards cannot adequately provide for substitute teachers items
 - b. Schools that will be given low priority:
 - (1) Large schools which can adopt alternatives for teacher classes:
 - (2) Schools whose teachers go on leave for a relatively short period of time (less than 10 working days)
 - c. Assignment of substitute teachers:

Who should be given priority

- The most ranking in terms of past performance, edicational qualification and competencies
- (2) Teachers who had long/outlineous experience as a suburity with at least linefactory experience
- (3) Substitute teachers whose field of specialization matches that of the ones to be substituted

- (4) Only leaves due to maternity/sick leave will merit substitute teachers
- 2. This Office reminds officials responsible for hiring substitute teachers, that salaries of appointees that exceed the number allotted to each school division shall be charged to the appointing official.
- 3. These guidelines amend and/or supplement previous regulations issued regarding the hiring of substitute teachers.
- 4. Strict compliance with this Order is desired.
