LONG SESSION PLAN FOR TEACHERS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities

1. The present economic crisis gives urgency to the need for adopting austerity measures and for augmenting the income of low-salaried employees in order to cope with the situation.
2. In view of this, beginning next year, June 1984, schools shall adopt a long session plan wherever possible for teachers in order to make available to them a bigger block of time for pursuing peso-saving activities at home and undertaking income-augmenting projects and activities after regular school work.
3. Each long session shall consist of six continuous hours of actual teaching and/or related work.
4. Teachers on the long session plan are free after working for six hours.
5. School principals and head teachers shall be held responsible for developing with their teachers individual class programs and a total school plan that will accommodate one long session for teachers starting in the morning, e.g. 7:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. and another starting at noon, e.g. 12:00 - 6:00 p.m. In making decisions on scheduling, it is desirable to consult with the teachers, parents and pupils/students on time preferences.
6. In making decisions on teaching assignments, maximum utilization of school facilities and classrooms the whole day shall be an important consideration.
7. To insure smooth implementation of the Long Session Plan for teachers next school year, it is desired that preparations for it be made long before the start of classes.
8. Immediate dissemination of this Order is desired.
