CONSOLIDATING AND INTEGRATING ALL AUDIO-VISUAL RESOURCES IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION, CULTURE AND SPORTS

- 1. The Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports has, through the years, acquired adequate audio-visual resource capability to service educational development projects through the use of audio and video educational packages.
- 2. At present, however, the audio-visual facilities and equipment available, as well as the staff members who have been involved in educational media projects, are located in different divisions and offices of the Ministry. Such a setup not only weakens the potentials for optimum resource utilization but also increases the possibility of duplicating efforts in audio-visual work.
- 3. To ensure their maximum utilization, these audio-visual resources, both human and physical, shall be consolidated and integrated to form a single facility that shall be accessible to all MECS offices and programs for servicing the various audio-visual requirements of the Ministry.
- 4. To take charge of the management, maintenance and operation of the audio-visual facility, an Audio-Visual Management Group is hereby created under the Office of the Minister with Ms. Zenaida T. Domingo, PDIMO, as Manager, to be assisted by a technical staff with competence in the maintenance and application of A-V facilities and equipment.
- 5. The A-V Management Group shall have the following functions:
 - a. Assistance to and close coordination with the various requesting units of MECS in the planning, development, evaluation and distribution of audio-visual materials.
 - b. Assistance in the development of media information packages for public relations purposes.
 - c. Assistance in information campaigns with the use of radio and video broadcast-quality materials.
 - d. Conduct of training/orientation of MECS staff who may wish to learn the operations of an audio-visual facility.

- 6. The organizational setup of the audio-visual facility, which indicates work coordination with the different MECS audio-visual projects, is inclosed.
- 7. A space of 150 square meters on the 8th floor of the Palacio del Gobernador (MECS Central Office), Intramuros, Manila shall be allocated for the Office of the Audio-Visual Management Group, and all equipment, including the Japanese donation, the audio-visual recording studio and VTR editing equipment presently located at Marvin Plaza, and the Bureau of Elementary Education A-V equipment in the Palacio, shall be brought together and consolidated in this Office. The area shall be secured for the proper maintenance and safekeeping of the equipment.
- 8. Such sums as are necessary for the operation of the A-V Management Group shall be set aside out of funds to be determined by the Office of the Financial and Management Service.
- 9. Immediate dissemination of this MECS Order to all concerned is desired.
