1. In line with the operationalization of MECS Order No. 36, s. 1984, and the Memorandum of Agreement entered into by the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports (MECS) on one hand and the Federation of Agcrediting Associations of the Philippines (FAAP) on the other, there is created herewith a joint MECS-FAAP Liaison Committee on Accreditation with the following members:

- 2. The committee shall be responsible for the (a) continuing liaison between the MECS and FAAP until such time as the national accrediting body would be operationalized, and (b) for recommending to the parties herein, studies and proposals on accreditation of a national scope, such as additional benefits and fundings. Toward the attainment of the above responsibilities, the committee shall perform the following specific functions:
  - a. Conduct periodic assessment of the implementation of MECS Order No. 36, s. 1984;
  - b. Develop and assess incentive systems in support of accreditation;
  - Review and/or prepare recommendations in aid of policy formulation as may be deemed necessary; and
  - d. Serve as liaison committee between the MECS and the National Accrediting Agency.
