TECHNICAL AND VOCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS MEETING MINIMUM
STANDARDS UNDER DECS MEMORANDUM NO. 147, s. 1987
AUTHORIZED TO OFFER TECHNOLOGY COURSES EMBODIED
IN DECS ORDERS NOS. 50, 51 AND 52, s. 1987

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Superintendents, State Colleges and Universities
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

I. On the basis of a self-assessment undertaken by school administrators and their faculty using the self-evaluation instruments embodied in DECS Memorandum No. 147, s. 1987, selected and certified by DECS, TVET and Technical Panel Advisory Evaluation Team and recommended by Regional Directors to the Secretary of Education, Culture and Sports, the schools listed in the enclosure are hereby authorized to offer the technology courses embodied in DECS Orders Nos. 50, 51 and 52, s. 1987.

II. This authority is issued on condition that the schools comply:

- a. Gradually phase out the present courses being offered starting school year 1988-1989;
- b. Verify their faculty on the various requirements of the new technology courses;
- c. Undertake the institutional survey of local agro-industrial, commercial and various local business establishments to determine the need of graduates equipped with specific technology skills for self-employment and for entrepreneurial employment;
- d. Maintain satisfactory standards in physical facilities, laboratory and other tools and equipment and library books and references required for every course to be offered;
- e. Submit a budget report on the current budget and a statement of intention to maintain the minimum standards of facilities and

4. Install a career guidance and placement services re-oriented on the kind of services it shall render to the students.

5. A team composed of representatives from the Bureau, the Technical Panel and the DECSRO shall monitor all schools authorized to offer the new courses and assist in the implementation seeing to it that the minimum standards are met and specific funds for instruction and OIT are available for the program to be offered.

6. The technical and vocational institutions classified under the tertiary level are listed by category in the inclosure. Only the Category I institutions are authorized to offer the new courses effective the first semester of the school year 1968-1969.

7. Technical and vocational schools (public/private) whose self-assessment have not been verified by the Evaluation Team are encouraged to realign their resources and are encouraged to send their faculty for upgrading to the National Center for Teacher Education and Staff Development (NCTESD) at Marikina Institute of Science and Technology (MIST), Marikina, Metro Manila. Additional list of qualified institutions shall be released in a succeeding DECS Order after the Evaluation Team shall have verified the result of the self-assessment.

8. Private technical institutions duly recognized by the government with courses that are qualified for voluntary accreditation shall implement the new programs embodied in this Order. Other public and private technical and vocational schools not covered by this Order shall continue to offer their present post-secondary programs until such time that they meet the conditions enumerated in paragraph 2 of this Order to offer the new courses.

9. Strict compliance with this Order by all concerned is enjoined.

LETTERS TO THE CATEGORIZATION OF TECHNICAL AND VOCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS

Category 1

Schools classified under this Category are identified to offer the new courses effective on the first semester of school year 1988-1989. The final identification of priority schools was part of the workshop output of Chiefs, Assistant Chiefs and Supervisors of the TVED's of the Regional Offices held in accordance with DECS Memo. No. 92, s. 1988. In preparation for the pilot implementation, these institutions shall undertake regional workshops of the technical and related subject instructors and supervisors on the use of the new materials. A training program of the technical and tool subjects faculty shall be offered at the NCTEED at MIST, Marikina, Metro Manila.

Category 2

These schools meet the general standards for post-secondary courses but are deficient in specific course requirements such as adequate budget for the program, qualified faculty and basic tools and equipment for the course. These schools may be given a minimum of one semester to one year to realign their courses to come-up with the specific requirements. Schools that are certified by the Tech-Voc Divisions that they have met the deficiencies may offer the new courses effective on the semester following such certification.

Category 3

Schools that passed the institutional assessment but are considered in this Category such as agricultural and fishery schools (in the absence of DECS issuance on such minimum standards to offer 5 months, 1 year and 2 year technical courses) and other technical and vocational schools with budgetary constraints and faculty requirements are given one (1) year to two (2) years to upgrade their schools before another re-assessment by the Team maybe done to qualify them to offer the new courses.

Category 4

Schools that have not undergone the institutional assessment and Team verification or whose institutional rating fall below the passing mark of 1.50 are encouraged to realign their resources and may request the DECS-RO Tech-Voc Division for assessment of their institutional capabilities for the verification by the National Team. Administrators of those schools are encouraged to send their faculty for upgrading at the NCTEED at MIST, Marikina, Metro Manila.
