

MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

TO : ALL HEADS OF DEPARTMENTS, BUREAUS AND AGENCIES
OF THE NATIONAL/LOCAL GOVERNMENTS INCLUDING
GOVERNMENT-OWNED AND/OR CONTROLLED CORPORATIONS

SUBJECT : Updated List of Positions Covered by Resolution
No. 435, s. 1980

In Resolution No. 435, s. 1980, the Commission adopted a system of granting eligibilities to persons occupying positions in the career service, fitness for which can be gauged not by the usual written tests, but through successful work performance over a period of time.

Attached to the Resolution was a list of positions appointments to which may be made initially by the appointing authority under temporary status.

Since the issuance of said Resolution, several positions have been added to, or deleted from, the original list after a review of their respective duties and responsibilities.

In view thereof, the Commission, in its Resolution No. 89-039, dated January 17, 1989, updated the list of positions covered by said Resolution No. 435. Attached is the updated list consisting of 316 positions.

RESOLUTION NO. 89-039

WHEREAS, the Commission is empowered to promulgate policies, standards, guidelines and rules governing appointments to various positions in the government service;

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 435, s. 1980 the Commission adopted a system of determining fitness of applicants for positions in the career service taking into consideration the knowledge, abilities and skills for successful performance which cannot be measured by a written test; and also provided that other positions may be added to those listed in said Resolution;

WHEREAS, since the issuance of said Resolution several positions have been added to said list including those positions deemed covered by said Resolution by virtue of the Commission's approval of their corresponding qualification standards; others have been deleted;

WHEREAS, the Commission deems it necessary to update the list of positions falling under Resolution No. 435, s. 1980;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission Resolves that only the positions listed in Annex "A" hereof are covered by said Resolution No. 435, s. 1980 and that any subsequent addition or deletion thereto can only be validly done through Commission Resolutions.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately.

RESOLUTION NO. 435, S. 1980

WHEREAS, the Commission is authorized by law to promulgate policies, standards and guidelines governing recruitment and selection of employees to first and second level positions in the career service;

WHEREAS, pursuant to this authority, Section 2, Rule I of the Civil Service Rules on Personnel Actions and Policies provides that examinations may be assembled or unassembled and the examination may take into consideration the experience, education, aptitude, capacity, skills, knowledge and potential of the applicant;

WHEREAS, Section 14 of the said rule further provides that the Commission shall promulgate, when the need arises, rules and regulations governing the conduct of tests other than written, oral, physical, performance and testimonial which it may consider to be of a suitable, impartial or practical character;

WHEREAS, in line with the provision above, the holding of open unassembled examination was closed on December 28, 1979 so that in their place a system which would determine fitness of applicants for positions that were covered by these examinations be adopted, which would take into consideration changes in qualification and job requirements; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provision of Section 5, Rule III of the Civil Service Rules on Personnel Actions and Policies, the Commission has adopted a new system.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission RESOLVED, as it hereby RESOLVES, to adopt the following procedure in granting eligibility to positions that are included in the attached lists.

An applicant may be initially issued a temporary appointment to any of the positions in the attached list, as well as other functionally related positions, in which he has had one year of experience in the government service or in any reputable private enterprise which experience, however, may be substituted; provided, that he meets the other requirements for appointment to the position. If the appointing authority finds that the appointee has continuously rendered satisfactory service during his one-year temporary appointment, he may renew the appointment, propose the same for change of status from temporary to permanent, and submit it to the Commission for approval.

The performance ratings of the appointee for the two grading periods during his temporary appointment and a certificate of completion of satisfactory service issued by the appointing authority shall be submitted with the appointment to the Commission. Eligibility shall be granted upon compliance with the foregoing requirements.

As a guide to the appointing authorities, the corresponding Schedule of Eligibility which is based on the qualification requirements for the position to be filled is indicated in the attached list of positions. Other positions may be added to the list as may be determined by the Commission.

THIS RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

SUBSTITUTION ALLOWED

Relevant education, experience or training course in excess of the minimum required shall be used interchangeably to offset deficiencies.

1. Deficiency in the education requirement may be substituted by any or a combination of the following at the rate of one academic year of formal study for every
 - a. Six months of relevant/specialized experience
 - b. Three months of relevant/specialized training grant
 - c. One hundred hours consisting of one or more relevant/specialized training courses
2. Every year of deficiency in the experience requirement shall be substituted by any or a combination of the following:
 - a. Three units of relevant/specialized study
 - b. One month of relevant/specialized training grant
 - c. One hundred hours of relevant/specialized training grant

1. In the interest of efficient and effective implementation of the Typhoon Resistant Schoolbuilding Project in Region V funded thru a grant from the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA), a Project Advisory Group (PAG) is hereby constituted, the main purpose of which is to provide policy directions in the implementation of the aforesaid project. The PAG will be chaired by the Undersecretary for Foreign Assisted Projects and concurrently the Executive Director of EDPITAF whose members will be as follows:

2. Three (3) non-DECS personalities have also been invited to join the PAG as members to represent the two (2) government departments that will actively participate in the implementation of the Project:

- a. Undersecretary Cesar N. Sarino representing the Department of Local Government (DLG);
- b. Undersecretary Teodoro T. Encarnacion and
- c. Dir. Jose Regalado, Regional Director, Region V representing the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH).

3. In order to effectively coordinate the pre-implementation and implementation activities including the monitoring and evaluation of the progress of the Project, a full-time Project Coordination and Implementation Group (PCIG) lodged at EDPITAF is also hereby created which will be assisted on an on-call basis by one senior staff each from the Office of the Planning Service and the Physical Facilities Division of the Bureau of Secondary Education. Authority is therefore granted the Undersecretary for Foreign Assisted Projects to hire the most qualified staff and constitute the PCIG immediately.

4. The DECS has also been assured by the DPWH that should the need arises, one senior technical staff each from that Department's Bureau of Design and Bureau of Construction can be tapped on an on-call basis to similarly assist the PCIG in the pursuit of its functions.

5. The Bureaus of Elementary and Secondary Education are enjoined to assist the PCIG likewise.

6. The EDPITAF, being the lead agency for the Project shall be responsible and accountable for all project implementation activities.
