REVIVING THE GRANTING OF CREDITS/WEIGHT POINTS  
TO GSP ACHIEVEMENTS AND AWARDS

To: Bureau Directors/Cultural Agency Directors  
Regional Directors  
Directors of Services and Heads of Units/Centers

1. In view of the nationwide clamor of many teachers and school officials to restore the practice of crediting awards and certificates of the Girl Scouts of the Philippines for merit promotion purposes to serve as incentive to DECS personnel for their exemplary service and meritorious accomplishments, the Department is hereby reviving the said practice.
2. Henceforth, the qualification, achievement and awards given by the Girl Scouts of the Philippines to DECS organic personnel in recognition of their meritorious services and accomplishments shall be credited a maximum of two (2) points in the DECS Merit Promotion System as indicated in particulars in Inclosure I.
3. The inclosed guidelines should be strictly followed as spelled out.
4. The GSP National Office shall verify and certify to the achievements of any teacher-grantee and issue the corresponding National Award certificate as recommended by the Local Council.
5. All DECS issuances contrary to the provisions of this Order are hereby rescinded.
6. Immediate dissemination of this Order to all concerned is desired.
7. Please be guided accordingly.

## GUIDELINES FOR CREDITS TO GSP ACHIEVEMENTS AND AWARDS

I. ACHIEVEMENTS (Specialization and Qualification relevant to education) will be credited a maximum of two (2) points as follows:

A. Camp Management Scheme or Trainers Scheme  
(attachment "A") (attachment "B")

Asia Pacific Training  
Pool Member - 1.50 point

GSP National Training  
Pool Member - 1.25 point

Camper's License or Trainer's Diploma - 1.00 point

Camper's Permit or Trainer's Credentials - 0.75 point

Star Holiday Permit ( ) or Specialist Trainer's  
Quartermaster Certificate) Certificate - 0.50 point

Campcraft Certificate - 0.25 point

B. Outstanding Accomplishment

Outstanding Troop Leader (attachment "C") - 1.50 point

Asia Pacific Leader's Qualification  
Certificate (attachment "D") - 1.00 point

II. NATIONAL AWARDS (Attachment "E") will be credited a maximum of two (2) points as follows:

A. Troop Leaders/Committee Members/Other adults

Gold/Gold Service Award - 1.25 point

Silver/Silver Service Award - 0.75 point

Bronze/Bronze Service Award - 0.50 point

B. Jade, Coral, Ruby (and other Gems) Award - 0.25 point

III. Special Awards such as Plaques of Recognition given by the Council/Regional/National Awards Committee shall be credited a maximum of two (2) points as follows:

National - 1.25 point

Regional - 0.75 point

Council - 0.50 point

IV. To ensure quality control in the certification and awards to teacher grantees, the GSP Council Awards Committee screens and processes all pertinent records duly endorsed by GSP District Committees.
