AMENDMENTS TO THE GUIDELINES FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION  
OF THE COLLEGE FACULTY DEVELOPMENT FUND (CFDF)  
PROGRAM UNDER RA 6728 FOR SY 1993-1994

To: Bureau Directors and Regional Directors  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The Memorandum of Agreement that took effect December 31, 1992 provides for the transfer of management of the College Faculty Development Fund (CFDF) Program from the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS) to the Fund for Assistance to Private Education (FAPE).
2. To enrich and further develop the College Faculty Development Fund Program under the present management, certain portions of the original guidelines, inclosure to DECS Order No. 60, s. 1991, were amended to provide for change in the amount of financial assistance granted to the faculty scholar, a wider selection of academic programs, and additional number of training centers across regions.
3. Inclosed are the guidelines of the College Faculty Development Fund Program under Republic Act No. 6728, SY 1993-1994, under the management of the Fund for Assistance to Private Education, for the information and guidance of all concerned.
4. Immediate dissemination and implementation of this Order is desired.
