- Э. further enhance To the basic skills of students enrolled in the said curriculum, time allotment complicated Mathematics subjects in the third and fourth years is hereby authorized to shift from sixty (60) minutes to eighty (80) minutes daily or a total of four hundred (400) minutes per week.
