## [REPUBLIC ACT NO. 8190]

AN ACT GRANTING PRIORITY TO RESIDENTS OF THE SCHOOL IS LOCATED, IN THE APPOINTMENT SCHOOLTEACHERS OR ASSIGNMENT BARANGAY, MUNICIPALITY OR CITY WHERE THE OF CLASSROOM PUBLIC

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:
