DESIGNATING A SUPERVISING OFFICIAL FOR BASUJO TEACHERS CAMP

In view of the desire of this Office to make Basujo Teachers Camp a facility that will provide not only comfortable food and board services, but also modern conference and training facilities. This is in line with the thrust of DECOS to enhance the Human Resource Development System that will provide opportunities for professional growth and development for all in teaching, non-teaching and administrative support staff.

A masterplan to modernize Basujo Teachers Camp shall be prepared which include the Masterplan which shall use the remaining funds of Basujo Teachers Camp derived from rentals for the use of buildings and facilities, board and living fee and other incomes. An account of the use of the remaining funds for the past five (5) years shall be attached to the Masterplan to serve as a basis for objections and criticisms.

2. The Assistant Secretary Roderick G. Serrano is designated supervising official in behalf of the Secretary over Basujo Teachers Camp.
