1. In the interest of the service, Undersecretary Nilo L. Rosas is hereby designated as Undersecretary for Mindanao Concerns.
2. As DECS key officer for Mindanao Basic Education Concerns, he will be responsible for the coordination of:
 - Implementation concerns for on-going programs and projects for the Mindanao regions;
 - Preparation of proposed programs and projects such as the Mindanao Basic Education Development Project (MBEDP) with the ADB;
 - Special Concerns for Mindanao such as the ICCs, Madrasah Education, Peace Education and others;
3. He will also serve as the overall coordinator of the National Steering Committee for the Comprehensive Mindanao Education Program (CMEP) and oversee the operations of the CMEP-PMO, or any group that may be assigned as Secretariat.
4. In performing the above tasks, Undersecretary Nilo L. Rosas is authorized to draw staff support from relevant Service Units, Bureaus, Centers and Project Units.
5. This Order shall take effect immediately.

GRANT OF AMELIORATION ASSISTANCE BENEFIT

To: Undersecretaries
Assistant Secretaries
Bureau/Center/Service/Regional Directors
Cultural Agencies Directors
Chiefs of Divisions and Heads of Units

1. Pursuant to Administrative Order No. 37 dated November 21, 1998, entitled "Authorizing the Grant of Amelioration Assistance To All Government Personnel and Prohibiting Payments of Similar Benefit in Future Years Unless Authorized by the President" as implemented by Budget Circular No. 16 dated November 26, 1998, the grant of amelioration assistance (AA) as fringe benefit is hereby authorized to all DECS officials and employees, chargeable against any available savings.
2. This benefit shall be given to each official and employee of the Department regardless of salary and appointment status, who have rendered at least four (4) months of service as of the payment of the said benefit except to the following:
 - a. those who are serving under service contracts;
 - b. those who are Absent Without Leave (AWOL);
 - c. those who are no longer in the service due to retirement/resignation/separation/death or for whatever reasons at the date of payment;
 - d. those who are meted penalties for work-connected offenses in CY 1998.
3. The maximum amount authorized for each qualified personnel is Seven Thousand Pesos (P7,000.00) only.
4. The AA of DECS personnel who are on full-time or part-time detail with another government agency or special project shall be drawn from the DECS, their mother agency, and vice-versa. Part-time personnel shall be entitled to one-half (1/2) of the benefit of a full-time personnel. In the case of those who are paid from project funds, the benefit shall be drawn from the same source where they draw their salaries.

5. Those who have actually rendered less than four (4) months of service and are still in the service at the time of payment of AA, shall be entitled to an amount proportionate to actual service rendered as follows:

<u>Actual Length of Service</u>	<u>Amount</u>
Less than 1 month	0% of amount due
1 month but less than 2 months	25% of amount due
2 months but less than 3 months	50% of amount due
3 months but less than 4 months	75% of amount due

6. The AA of DECS personnel who transferred to another agency/office shall be borne by the new agency/office. Likewise, the benefit of personnel from another agency who transferred to DECS shall be paid by the latter.
7. The payment of the benefit herein granted, which shall be made not earlier than December 15, 1998, shall be charged from the respective savings of each office/bureau/center/region. The allotments pertaining to accounts payable which are proposed for reversion may be tapped as funding source, subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
8. In the event that cash allocations are not sufficient, the Regional/Bureau/Center Directors, and Heads of Cultural Agencies and Units are enjoined to closely coordinate with the Regional Directors of the Department of Budget and Management in their respective localities regarding requests for the issuance of Notices of Cash Allocation (NCAs) corresponding to the allotments/savings offered as source for the payment to their personnel of the benefit herein authorized.

DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY TO THE SCHOOLS SUPERINTENDENTS

To:

- 1. Undersuperintendents
- 2. Assistant Secretaries
- 3. Bureau/Regional/Center/Service Directors
- 4. Schools Superintendents
- 5. Others Concerned.

Pursuant to the principle of decentralization and empowerment; the exercise of authority over certain functions is hereby delegated to the Schools Division Superintendents as follows:

1. Appraise appointments, promotions, transfers, reassignments, and details of personnel of the Schools Division Office occupying crucial position and by the authority of the Secretary, those occupying Level II positions, except Assistant Schools Division Superintendents. The Schools Division Superintendents shall continue to approve the appointments of teachers pursuant to the provisions R.A. 4670 and 8190;
2. Approve requests for study, vacation, sick, maternity, leave allowances, with or without pay and resignations of the concerned personnel and;
3. Approve the dropping of personnel from the rolls.

This Order replaces/revises Sec. A(1, 3, 7, 10 and 11) of M.S.C.S. Order No. 48, s. 1986 and all other ordinances inconsistent herewith.

This Order takes effect immediately.
