The Department of Education, Culture and Sports, in fulfillment of its duties of administratively managing the education system, has issued the Circular Letter on the Out-of-School Adult Education Program No. 37, s. 1987, dated July 19, 1987. The program was to provide the opportunity for adults aged 20-50 to continue their education and to start a new career path. The program was to be implemented at the public level of government and was to be carried out by various

As a matter of policy, responsibility for the implementation of the program is the responsibility of the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports.

In order to ensure the success of the program, it is necessary to provide guidance and assistance to the schools, institutes, and universities. The schools, institutes, and universities are to be given the necessary administrative and financial support.

The Department of Education, Culture and Sports, in fulfillment of its duties, has issued this decree to provide guidance and assistance to the schools, institutes, and universities.

MEMORANDUM FOR THE DIRECTOR, BUREAU OF REVENUE AND TAXATION
RE: THE PROPOSED CHANGES TO THE STATE INCOME TAX PROGRAM

To ensure the proper implementation of the proposed changes to the State Income Tax Program, the following guidelines should be followed:

1. The proposed changes to the State Income Tax Program should be implemented in a manner that is consistent with the provisions of the State Constitution and the provisions of the State Tax Code.

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IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES FOR THE TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE TO THE SIVUCA PROGRAM

To ensure the smooth implementation of the SP/OSA - Programa, the following guidelines for the providers of technical assistance are identified:

1. The Bureau of Secondary Education shall be included in the SP/OSA Program implementation. It shall track the implementation of the educational innovation, forge partnerships with governmental and non-governmental leading institutions, and perform objective and participatory roles to ensure effective program implementation.
2. The Regional Offices (Rovato, Balmuccia, and Gussato) are the implementing partners of the SP/OSA Program. They shall report to the lead institution a monthly status report and yearly report. Agencies/ASE in charge of program implementation at the District and Regional Offices shall furnish the data.
3. Owing to the nature of the SP/OSA Program, the provider continues to be engaged in the design of courses affected the systematic implementation and adoption of innovative activities. Provided that actions conform with the program concept and the lead institution is duly informed.
4. Fostering effective partnerships between groups and within government and non-governmental institutions to encourage an open, free and one-way flow of information and ensure technical and financial support and expertise.
5. First of all, keep the lead institution properly informed on matters of administrative cooperation and development, curriculum models and training programs, so to be needed support can be provided smoothly.
6. By October 31, institutionalization of the program shall have been achieved. The regional division offices will offer over 1000 as a law institution for the program.
