

## CREATING A TASK FORCE TO REVIEW/REVISE/MODIFY EXISTING PTA/PTCA GUIDELINES/ISSUANCES

- 1. Pursuant to the decision of the Management Committee during the 13th MANCOM Meeting, a Task Force is created to formulate, review, revise, modify the existing PTA/PTCA guidelines and/or issuances in order to resolve and address numerous complaints and/or disputes, relative to the recognition, administration and management, affairs, and election of the Officers of the Parents-Teachers Association (PTA)/Parents-Teachers-Community Association (PTCA).
