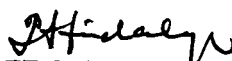

**SUBMISSION OF THE PRIORITY LISTS OF SCHOOLBUILDING PROJECTS TO BE FUNDED UNDER THE INITIAL RELEASE OF PHP500M FOR CY 2006 DepED SCHOOLBUILDING PROGRAM FOR AREAS EXPERIENCING ACUTE CLASSROOM SHORTAGE**

To : DepED ARMM Regional Secretary  
Regional Directors  
Schools Division/City Superintendents

1. The President has instructed the Department of Budget and Management to release five hundred million pesos (**P500, 000,000.00**) for the construction of additional school buildings of the Department of Education. The amount is intended to address the classroom requirements of schools categorized in the Basic Education Information System (BEIS) as *Red* and *Black* Schools. Enclosure A is the Guidelines for the Preparation of the Priority Lists of School Buildings to be funded under this budget.
2. In making the final list of priority schools, please take note of the budgetary ceiling for each region and the standard cost for the different project components. Field Offices shall allocate 2/3 of the amount for elementary and 1/3 for the secondary schools based on actual needs, provided that the actual allocation for both levels does not exceed the budgetary ceiling of the region. Further, the list of recipient schools shall be drawn from the updated Instructional Rooms Analysis of the Basic Education Information System (BEIS) data (SY 2005-2006). Enclosure B is the summary of regional allocation for this particular release.
3. An ocular inspection of the proposed recipient schools shall be undertaken to assess current site conditions and to determine actual classroom needs/repair as well as the corresponding cost thereof.
4. The project listings should be duly approved by both the Regional Director and Schools Division/City Superintendent.
5. The Priority Lists must be submitted to the **Physical Facilities and Schools' Engineering Division** at 4<sup>th</sup> Floor Bonifacio Bldg., DepED Complex, Meralco Ave., Pasig City with Telefax No. (02) 633-72-63/638-4108 and e-mail address at pfsed\_010305@yahoo.com, on or before January 27, 2006.

**P500 Million Initial Release for DepED School Building Program  
for CY2006 for Areas Experiencing Acute Classroom Shortage**

**A. Identification of Recipient Schools**

1. In the identification of recipient schools for this program, priority should be given to schools that belong to the Red and Black Spectrum of the latest BEIS data and those schools in areas with indigenous people (IPs).
2. The identified recipient school should have sufficient school site for the construction of additional classrooms. In the case of Black schools, these should have a school site with corresponding site ownership documents, e.g. TCT, Deed of Donation, Usufruct Agreement. Tax declaration in the name of DepEd and the local government unit (LGU) will be considered by the Department as an acceptable site ownership document, provided, however that there is a certification from the Assessor's Office that the lot has no adverse claimant.

However, justifications shall be made by the respective offices for the changes in the costing for approval of the Central Office.

**C. Modes of Implementation**

School building projects shall be undertaken by DepED through contracting or under a Memorandum of Agreement between the Local Government Units and DepED Division Office.
