> ORGANIZATION OF PRESCHOOL CLASSES UNDER THE PRESCHOOL SERVICE CONTRACTING PROGRAM FOR SY 2007-2008

To: Regional Directors Schools Division/City Superintendents

- The Department of Education in conformity with the Education for All (EFA) goal of making Basic Learning Needs available to all through various means will continue to implement the Preschool Service Contracting Program.
- 2. The Preschool Service Contracting Program is an alternative delivery system that engages the services of private schools and the Non-Government Organizations (NGOs) in providing early learning experience for five-year old children whose parents cannot afford to send them to any preschool.
- 3. For school year 2007-2008, the Program will be expanded to cover more disadvantaged five year-old children who are least likely to enter school in 4th, 5th and 6th class municipalities, urban poor and relocation areas.
- 4. New preschool classes will be organized in public schools where there is no existing preschool classes and in barangays without daycare centers. The preschool classes organized under the Program as of SY 2006-2007 are enjoined to be sustained.
- 5. Classes start on Monday, October 1, 2007 and end on Friday, March 28, 2008. Allocation of number of classes to be organized (Enclosure No. 2) and the implementation guidelines (Enclosure No. 1) are enclosed for compliance.

6. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Order is directed.

GUIDELINES ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF PRESCHOOL SERVICE CONTRACTING PROGRAM FOR SY 2007-2008

I. General Guidelines

- 1. Preschool classes shall be organized in Public Schools with no existing preschool class and in Barangays without Daycare under 4th 5th and 6th class municipalities, urban poor communities and relocation areas.
- 2 Only those children who will be six years old by June 2008 are eligible for enrolment.
- 3. Classes will start in October 1, 2007 and shall end on March, 2008.
- 4. Only the registered Preschools/Early Learning Centers, Colleges and Universities offering Education Course and NGOs with education mandate are qualified to become Service Providers. As such, however, they must be financially capable to advance funds for the sponsored preschool class. By NO means a Private Person be contracted as Service Provider.
- THREE HUNDRED PESOS (Php300.00) per child per month shall be paid in full to the service provider from which the salary of teachers, instructional materials and administrative costs will be drawn.
- 6. No amount from the Preschool Service Contracting Program shall be used for monitoring of PSSC classes or pay Honoraria of DepEd Officials involved in the implementation of the Program.
- 7. The Preschool Service Contracting Class is different from the PTCA-organized classes, hence no payment shall be made to any PTCA.
- II. Responsibilities of the Service Providers
 - A. Enter into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with DepEd Division Office.
 - B. Provide the following:
 - salary of preschool teacher(s) of not less than Php3,000.00/month every end of the month
 - Instructional materials at least three workbooks (Communication Skills in English, Filipino and Mathematics) and story books per child
 - Basic school supplies for the pupils and the teacher sufficient for the six →
 month period
 - C. Monitor the preschool classes as often as necessary.

III. Responsibilities of the DepEd

A. Central Office

- Monitor the implementation of the program
- Evaluate the conduct of the program
- Facilitate release of funds on time

B. Regional Office

- Facilitate transfer of funds to the Division Offices the soonest time possible.
- Submit to the Central Office, later than November 15, 2007 the hereunder prescribe report format.

C. Division Office

- Organize preschool classes with a maximum of twenty five (25) and a minimum of fifteen (15) pupils per class
- Screen Service Provider(s) and sign MOA with them on the basis of their financial capability
- Assist the Service Provider(s) in hiring of teacher(s) and securing classroom if necessary
- Orient the concerned teachers and school administrators including the Service Provider(s) on the proper implementation of the Preschool Service Contracting Program
- Pay the Service Provider(s) in full (i.e. THREE HUNDRED PESOS = P300.00) per child per month
- Monitor the conduct of classes and provide technical assistance to Service Contracting teachers
- Submit an accomplishment report to the Regional Office on or before April 15, 2007.
