**SUBMISSION OF THE PRIORITY LISTS OF RECIPIENT SCHOOLS TO BE FUNDED UNDER THE CY 2008 DepED SCHOOL BUILDING PROGRAM FOR AREAS EXPERIENCING ACUTE CLASSROOM SHORTAGE (RED AND BLACK SCHOOLS)**

To: DepED ARMM Regional Secretary  
Regional Directors  
Schools Division/City Superintendents

1. The appropriation for the CY 2008 DepED School Building Program for areas experiencing acute classroom shortage will be utilized to address the classroom requirements of schools belonging to the Red & Black codes of the Basic Education Information System (BEIS). **Red and Black Schools** refers to: (1) where the number of students divided by the existing number of classrooms shall result to a classroom-student ratio of 1:56 or more, (2) those where classrooms are temporary in nature or makeshift structures; or (3) those without any classrooms at all.
2. In making the final list of priority schools, please take note of the long list of red and black schools drawn from the updated Instructional Rooms Analysis of the BEIS data (SY 2007-2008) distributed to the Division Physical Facilities Coordinators (DPFCs) during the 3<sup>rd</sup> National Convention of Physical Facilities Coordinators and DepED Project Engineers held in Davao City, the budgetary ceiling for each region, and the standard cost for the different project components. Field offices shall allocate based on the actual needs, provided that the total allocation for both levels does not exceed the budgetary ceiling of the division. The guidelines on the identification of recipient schools under this program are enclosed in Annex "A". The summary of regional allocation is in Annex "C".
3. The project listings should be prepared by the Division Physical Facilities Coordinator and duly approved by the Schools Division Superintendent.
4. The priority lists of schools shall be submitted to the **Physical Facilities and Schools Engineering Division (PFSED)** at **4<sup>th</sup> Floor Bonifacio Bldg., DepED Complex, Meralco Ave., Pasig City** with telefax nos. (02) 633-72-63/638-41-08/638-71-10 and e-mail address at [pfsed\\_010305@yahoo.com](mailto:pfsed_010305@yahoo.com), following the format in Annex "D" on or before **February 16, 2008**.
5. For those divisions who will not be able to comply with the deadline set in Item 4, the PFSED will prepare the list which will also be drawn from the long list of the red and black schools mentioned in Item 2.

6. A team composed of PFSED engineers and the Regional Physical Facilities Coordinator will conduct site appraisal and validation based on the submitted lists from the filed offices to determine and assess the current site conditions to determine actual classroom needs, as well as the corresponding cost thereof. In the event that the list of recipient schools do not need additional classrooms based on site validation made, the results of the assessment shall govern and a new school shall be proposed for implementation.
7. To ensure that the school buildings can be used by the start of the School Year 2008-2009, the President instructed the DepED to complete the construction of school buildings during the summer vacation period. Thus, procurement shall immediately commence once the listing is approved by the Schools Division superintendent.
8. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Order is directed.

**GUIDELINES FOR THE PREPARATION OF PRIORITY LISTS OF SCHOOL BUILDINGS TO BE FUNDED UNDER THE CY 2008 DepED SCHOOL BUILDING PROGRAM FOR AREAS EXPERIENCING ACUTE CLASSROOM SHORTAGE (RED AND BLACK SCHOOLS)**

**A. Manner of Allocation**

The Lumpsum appropriation for the CY 2008 School Building Program is equitably distributed to all legislative districts on the basis of classroom shortage, as computed from SY 2007-2008 Basic Education Information System (BEIS) and on the assumption of 1:45 double shift (1:45 DS) session.

**B. Identification of Recipient Schools**

1. In the identification of recipient schools for this program, priority should be given to schools that belong to the following categories:
  - a. Schools with Classroom to Student/Pupil Ratio of more than 1:56 or those that fall under the red zone of the BEIS;
  - b. Schools without existing permanent structures or those that fall under the black zone of the BEIS; and
  - c. Schools located in areas with indigenous peoples.
2. The identified recipient school should have sufficient school site for the construction of additional classrooms. In the case of Black schools, these should have a school site with corresponding site ownership documents, (e.g. TCT, Deed of Donation, Usufruct Agreement). Tax declaration in the name of DepEd and the local government unit (LGU) will be considered by the Department as an acceptable site ownership document, provided, however, that there is a certification from the Assessor's Office that the lot has no adverse claimant.
3. To avoid duplication and the tedious process of realignment of projects, the Region/Division shall ensure the conduct of the site appraisal/validation of the proposed listing prior to the submission to the Central Office.

**C. Standard Classroom Dimension**

- a. 7m x 7m classroom – To be adopted for schools located in provinces where the classroom-pupil/student ratio is not more than 1:45.

- b.1. 7m x 9m classroom – this will be used in schools located in semi-urban areas or in urbanizing portions of municipalities such as the poblacion where the classroom to pupil/student ratio is more than 1:45. ALL PUBLIC SECONDARY SCHOOLS WILL ADOPT the 7m x 9m dimension regardless of its location and class size.
- b.2. 7m x 9m for medium-rise school building – this will be adopted for schools in the National Capital Region (NCR) and in urban of high growth areas or where the school is with limited space/site. At least a 2-storey structure shall be planned to be erected.

#### **D. Standard Cost of School Building**

The regionalized costs of school buildings are based on the prevailing cost of construction materials and hauling in a particular region. Refer to **Annex “B”** on the tabulated costs of school buildings per region.

#### **E. Implementation Procedure**

1. This year’s School Building Program shall be implemented through contracting using the Principal-led School Building Program and following the procurement guidelines of the World Bank as this project is covered in the loan agreement with the Bank under BESRA-NPSBE. Single or clustered projects amounting to \$100,000.00 or Php4,500,000.00 (using the current rate of \$1=P45) shall be implemented using the Principal-led SBP Scheme.
2. Single projects amounting to more than \$100,000.00 or Php4,500,000.00 shall be bidded by the Division/Regional Bids and Awards Committee using the National Competitive Bidding using the implementing rules and regulations of RA 9184.
3. Local Government Unit (LGU) who are interested to implement the school building projects may be allowed upon recommendation of the Division and Regional Office and approval of the Central Office and provided that a Memorandum of Agreement shall be perfected between the Department and the LGU concerned. Assessment of the LGU shall be made to determine their capability to implement the project by Administration.

#### **F. Coordination and Consultation**

To prevent duplication of recipient schools in the Regular School Building Program (RSBP) or in any other School Building Project being implemented by other agencies and NGOs, the Schools Division/ City Superintendents or their representatives may coordinate with the concerned Representative of the Legislative District, LGU



through the Local School Board, and other concerned entity on the preparation of the final list of recipient schools.

**G. Reporting Format/ Submission**

In preparing the list of recipient schools, the format shown in **Annex "D"** should be strictly followed. The Division Physical Facilities Coordinator (DPFC) should indicate his/her contact numbers (telephone number, fax number, cellular phone number) in the list for easy access in case clarification is needed.

It is emphasized that the final listing should be prepared in triplicate copies, the original copy to be submitted to the PFSED, duplicate copy to the Regional office and the triplicate copy to be retained by the Division office concerned.
