GUIDELINES ON THE UTILIZATION OF THE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE SPECIAL SCIENCE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PROJECT

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public Elementary Schools

- 1. In support to the Special Science Elementary School (SSES) Project, the Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE) shall be downloading Twenty-Six Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (26.5M) as financial assistance to the 57 pilot schools across the country.
- 2. Each of the fifty seven (57) public elementary schools identified as the pilot schools, the divisions and regions involved shall be provided funds to support the activities pursuant to the pilot implementation of the SSES project. (Enclosure No. 1).
- 3. The guidelines on the allocation, disbursement and liquidation is contained in Enclosure No. 2.
- 4. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Order is directed.

## GUIDELINES ON THE UTILIZATION OF THE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE SSES PROJECT

- 1. The 57 schools piloted will be allocated Four Hundred Eighteen Thousand, Four Hundred Twenty-One Pesos and Five Centavos (P418,421.05) each. The sixteen (16) regions involved shall be allotted Eighty-Two Thousand Eight Hundred Twelve Pesos and Fifty Centavos (P82,812.50) to fund the final screening to be conducted by the Regional Assessment Team, organization of the SSES classes and the provision of technical assistance. Twenty-Four Thousand Ninety Pesos and Ninety-One Centavos (P24,090.91) shall likewise be allotted to the divisions of the pilot schools for the monitoring, provision of technical assistance and evaluation of the program. (Enclosure No. 1)
- The amount to be allotted to each recipient schools will be released to the Schools Division Offices concerned thru the issuance of Sub-Allotment Release Order (Sub-ARO) by the Budget Division, DepEd, Central Office.
- 3. The amount granted per school shall be utilized to support activities of the SSES implementation:
  - Training/Professional upgrading of teachers and school heads,
  - Purchase of instructional materials including psychological tests,
  - Pupil development activities such as conduct of investigatory project development, leadership training, educational visits and student participation in Science related activities,
  - Conduct of INSET on the development of instructional materials and evaluation of learning
  - Travel expenses in the participation/attendance to conferences, study visits, and other activities relevant to the project implementation
- Regions/divisions and recipient schools shall be accountable for the disbursements and liquidation of funds. All expenses/disbursements shall be supported by Official Receipts, Reimbursement Expenses Receipts (RER) and/or Cash Invoices.
- 5. The head of SSES pilot schools shall submit its accomplishment report to the Bureau of Elementary Education through the Division Office and the financial statement to Mrs. Rhuna Catalan, OIC – Chief, Accounting Division, this Department. The Regional Office shall be furnished a copy of the report
